

The Hon. Commissioner's Court meet with a regular session June 9, 1919. The following members present:

The Court was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff, G. W. Alford, upon petition by required members of petitioners asking for second class public road to be established as follows: Beginning at W. L. Gooches place on what is known as holly bottom road, thence in a northerly direction passing near the Walker farm, thence by Busby McDaniel place, thence by the John Walker place intersecting Hemphill & Fairdale road at a point known as the Walker Hill, this order is granted and the holly bottom road is discontinued from the W. L. Gooch place to the south side of housing Bayou.

The accounts were allowed as per ledger.

Upon motion duly made and second the Court voted unanimously to place Isla voting precinct No. 10 in Commissioners Beat No. 4, the boundary lines of voting precinct No. 10 to be included in Commissioners Beat No. 4.

The Commissioners Court upon motion duly made and seconded condimed the land of the Santa Fe Right of Way, beginning one mile north of Pineland Texas, on the line of the Santa Fe Ry. Co. on the west side of Railroad tract thence in southerly direction to the intersection of the Bronson & Pineland road with the Hemphill & Pineland road the part condimed being the part of which the Bronson & Pineland road passes through and that a Jury of View appointed to assess the damages if any by reason of Pineland & Bronson road passing over said property and

Upon motion duly made and second the Court ordered that the rate per month to be charged on Civic fund to be raised from \$10.00 per month to \$25.00 per month.

The report of the Jury of View appointed by the Court to assess the damages to the property of Lenord Morris & M. W. McDonald came on to be considered the Court after due consideration rejected the report for the reason that through the Court through damages allowed excessive and that a new Jury of View be appointed, the Court allowed
