

The Hon. Commissioner's Court met in a regular session July 14, 1919.

The following members present:

The Court was opened by Proclamation of the Sheriff.

The following matters were had-

Accounts were allowed as per accounts allowed ledger, upon petition by required number of property tax paying voters asking that a special school tax election be held in Common School District # 16 for purpose of increasing the school tax from 20 cents and \$100.00 to 50 cents and \$100.00 valuation on all taxable property in said district it is therefore ordered that a special election be held in Common School district # 16 at school house in said District and that E. J. McGown be appointed presiding officer of said election and that same be held Aug., 9th, 1919.

The court having condemned the property of Miles McDaniel and L. Morris though which the Hemphill and Fairdale Road passes and the court having rejected the report of the Jury of View the Court appointed the following men to act as a Jury of View to go upon the property of Miles McDaniel and L. Morris and assess the damages if any by reason of said road passing over their property and the Court ordered them to meet on the ground July 26, 1919, D. W. McNaughton, E. T. Knighton and R. H. Dent.

The court having failed to agree on the place of right of way through the property of M. H. Ellison condemned the right of way through said property and appointed R. S. Noble W. H. Davidson and L. H. Chandler to go upon said property July 26 1919 and assess the damages if any to said property by reason of said road passing through said property.

The Court Allowed County Aid to following pastors- Mrs. Nannie Howard \$15.00 G. Randle \$5.00, Mrs. Nannie Meador \$10.00 J. W. Arnold \$5.00 Wede Smith \$15.00 for Alice Boaz.

Upon petition from required members of property tax paying voters in School District #35 asking for a special election to determine whether or not a majority of the resident property tax paying voters desire to issue bonds in said District for the purpose of building and

equipping an addition to the school building of wood material in said District the court ordered said election to be held August 16th 1919 at School house in said District and B. H. Smith is appointed presiding officer of said election.

Upon petition from required members of property tax paying voters in Common School District #25 asking for a special election to determine whether or not a majority of the residents property tax paying voters desire to issue Bonds for \$1200.00 in said District for the purpose of building and equipping a Public fund school building of wood material within said district the court ordered said election to be held August 15, 1919 at School house in said District and J. M. Bell is appointed presiding officer of said election.

Upon petition from required members of property tax paying voters in Common School District #12 asking for a special election to determine whether or not a majority of the residents property tax paying voters desire to issue Bonds for \$1500.00 in said district for the purpose of building one frame school building of wood material and equipping same within said district the court ordered said election to be held August 16, 1919 at School house in said district and E. B. Smith is appointed presiding officer of said election.

Upon petition from the required members of resident property tax paying voters in school dist. # 18 asking for a special election to determine whether or not a majority of the resident property tax paying voters desire to issue Bonds for \$1500.00 in said district for the purpose of building and constructing a wooden school building in said district the court ordered said election to be held August 16, 1919 at school house in said district and H. L. Pratt is appointed presiding officers of said election.

There being no further business the court adjourned.
