

Upon return of a special election held in Common School District No. 18, on the 4th day of October, 1919, upon the question as to whether said district should be consolidated with Common School District No. 1, the following results were declared: 5 for consolidation & 11 against consolidation.

The Hon. Commissioner's Court met in regular session Oct. 13th, 1919.

The court was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff, G. W. Alford.

The following matters with other together were had, the returning of School Bond election held common School District No. 14, on 26 day of Sept., 1919 upon the question of issuing \$1500.00 of school house bonds for said District, the following results was declared. For the Bonds 15 votes against the bonds 0 votes. The court ordered that County Judge prepare the necessary papers for the bonds.

Upon return of Special election held in Independent School District No. 1, on 4th day Oct. 1919 upon the question whether said school District would consolidate with Common School District 18, and Common School District No. 24, the following results was declared.

For Consolidation, 33 votes, against consolidation 1 vote. Upon returns of special election held in Common School district No. 18, on the 4th day of Oct. 1919 upon the question as to whether Common School District No. 18, should be consolidated with Geneva Independent School District No. 1, the following results was declared, for consolidation 14 votes against consolidation 11 votes, it was therefore ordered by the Court that Common School District No. 18, be consolidated with the Independent School District No. 1.

The court ordered the clerk to issue duplicate warrants out of the R. & B. Fund for \$13.50 in favor of S. T. McElroy on account of the original being lost.

Upon petition required a number of citizens asking that the change be made in road beginning at W. W. Boyette's place, thence in a northerly direction to W. F. Russell and intersects lower San Augustine & Milam road on line between W. F. Russell & C. A. Nethery said road was wanted.

Upon petition the Court transferred San Roberts & Metha Roberts from road leading from Myrtle Spring Grave Yard to V. E. Vickers place to the road leading from Carters Ferry road to Colera Bridge near Sexton, upon petition the Commissioners court to grant a public road beginning at a point on the Hemphill and Mattens Ferry road at the South east corner of what is known as the Joe McGee Field near the George Hanks place and running to the Hickory Bluff on the Sabine river.

Upon petition the Commissioners court granted the following public roads beginning at the Bridge on creek near the house occupied by Albert Boyd on A. A. Wilson farm thence in a westerly direction across A. A. Wilson land to A. R. Coopers land and thence across A. R. Coopers in a westerly direction to the Rock Spring road leading from the Milam, and San Augustine road to the old Shelbyville road.

The Accounts was allowed as per ledger.
