The Commissioner's Court was opened by proclamation of G. W. Alford Sheriff.

The following matters together with other were had.

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The Commissioner's having failed to reach adjustment as to value on the property of C. A. Nethery over which the Geneva & Hemphill High-Way passes over, the court appointed W. H. Davidson, I. W. Tatom & R. S. Noble, as road jury to assess the damages and condemn property for road property.

The following third class road was established beginning at E. R. Crossing in front of L. Lords' place and running in a northerly direction by N. A. Williams place, thence intersecting state high-way at T. G. Speights place.

#### RESOLUTIONS OF COMMISSIONER'S COURT PROVIDING FUNDS FOR CONSTRUCTION

Extract from the minutes of the Commissioner's Court of Sabine County, Texas, at meeting held at Hemphill, Texas, on the 8 day of Dec. 1919.

Upon the motion of Commissioner C. M. Bennett from Precinct No. 4, duly seconded, the following resolution was adopted:

Whereas, The commissioners' Court of Sabine County, Texas, has made application to the State Highway Department for State Aid, and through it to the Federal Government for Federal Aid to be used in the construction or reconstruction of the public road between Hemphill and Geneva in Sabine County, Texas, known as the High-way No. 8 A road, same being 13.69 miles in length; and,

Whereas, The cost of construction or reconstructing said road is estimated to be approximately 187,384.35 dollars, and.

Whereas, Application has been made for Federal Aid to the extent of \$85000.00 dollars; and,

Whereas, The Federal Government according to Regulation No. 4, Section 7, of the Secretary of Agriculture, requires, and the State also requires a statement from a county or district respecting the funds which are or will be made available for the construction or reconstruction of said road;

Now, Therefore be it resolved by the Commissioner's Court of Sabine County, That there is appropriated out of Book funds and set aside for the purpose above specified and subject to the order of the State Highway commission, the sum of \$102,384.35 Dollars, which fund shall be held solely for the purpose of constructing or reconstructing the road above mentioned; and if the actual cost of constructing this road should exceed the engineer's estimate therefor, the Commissioners' Court does pledge itself to pay from Bonds funds such additional amount as may be required to complete the proposed construction or reconstruction herein set forth; and,

It is further resolved, that the construction or reconstruction of the aforesaid road shall be done strictly in accordance with the plans and specifications as approved by the State Highway Department and the United States Department of Agriculture and the commissioners' court pledges itself to employ, if necessary, an engineer, who shall be satisfactory to the State Highway Department and to the United States Department of Agriculture.
