The Commissioner's court was opened by Proclamation of the Sheriff.

The accounts were allowed as account per ledger.

The Treasurer Report was examined and approved by the Comms. Court.

The Court fixed the County officers Salaries as follows:

District Clerk -----	\$700.00
County " -----	\$700.00
Sheriff -----	\$500.00
County Judge -----	\$1400.00

D. A. Easley, J. B. Hargroves and C. M. Bennett voted for \$1400.00 as Salary for County Judge
M. T. Bell voted against.

The court ordered that the County Treasurer be allowed 1/2 per cent commission on money paid out and received for the ensuing quarter.

X The county Health officer, W. C. Arthur having moved his place of residence from Sabine county, Texas, and the county Attorney having ruled that the county Health office was vacant, the court here and now declares said office vacant as aforesaid.

Upon motion duly made and second the court voted to appoint Dr. H. T. White as County health officer.
