

The Hon. Commissioner's Court met in special session on May 10, 1920.

The court was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff.

The tax collector filed his delinquent tax report for the year of 1919 and same was approved by the court and the Clerk was ordered to have publication made according to Law. The annual settlement of the tax collector for the year 1919 was filed and same was approved by the court. It is ordered by the court the sum of \$2665.60 be transferred from the account of road bond fund to the account of road & bridge fund for right of way fence moving and damages to land and that the County treasurer is hereby ordered to make the transfer on his record.

Upon the returns of a special school tax collection held common school district # 26, Sabine County, Texas, 1st day May 1920 to determine whether or not a tax of and at the rate of 50¢ on one hundred dollar valuation of all taxable property in said district shall be levied assessed and collected to supplement the State school fund appointment, the following results was declared for increase of school tax 10 votes against increase of school tax no votes. It is therefore ordered by the court that tax of and at the rate of 50¢ on \$100.00 valuation be assessed levied and collected.

Upon motion duly made and second Mr. Sharp \$10.00 for County Aid.

Upon petition of D. B. Smith the court ordered that 94 acres of land a part of D. Renfro survey be incorporated in stock law sub-division known as Geneva stock law sub-division being same land deeded to D. B. Smith by Mrs. M. E. Smith and heirs upon petition of J. H. Smith. The court ordered that 110 acres of land a part of D. Renfro survey be incorporated in stock law sub-division known as Geneva stock law

sub-division being same land deeded to J. H. Smith by Mrs. M. E. Smith et al.

The court approved the county Treas. report for past quarter, the court approved the quarterly report of W. R. Davidson as J. P. of Precinct No. 1, the court set the tax levy at Feb. term at the same rate as 1919 and it is therefore ordered that the following levy be made.

General county	25%	\$100.00	valuation	
R & B	15%	\$100.00	"	
Jury	05%	\$100.00	"	
Road Bond	90%	\$100.00	"	the above being the same as 1919 levy.

The court was closed and the board of Equilization was opened with all members present.

The Board of Equilization raised the values of property as per minutes of the board of equilization & the clerk was ordered to notify each property holder of such raise and to notify them the board of equilization June 28th, 1920 to hear any one that cares to show cause why said property should not be raised.

The board of equilization adjourned till June 28th, 1920.
