Upon return of a Special School Tax election held in common School district No. 29, to determine whether or not a tax of and at the rate of .50% on \$100.00 valuation upon all taxable property in said district held on 22nd day of May 1920, the following results was declared: For increase of School Tax 10 votes, against increase of School Tax 3 votes, it is therefore ordered by the court at last a tax of and at the rate of .50% on \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property levied, assessed, levied & collected to suppliment the State School appartment for said district.

Upon return of a special school tax election held in common school district No. 19, to determine whether or not a tax of and at the rate of \$.50 on \$100.00 valuation upon all taxable property in said District held on 22nd day of May 1920, the following results was declared: For increase of school tax 9 votes against increase of school tax 1 vote, it is therefore ordered by the court that a tax of and at tate of \$.50% on \$100.00 valuation of all taxable property be levied, assessed, levied and collected to suppliment the State school appartment of said district.
