The following matters together with others were had to-wit:

J. H. Travis Tax Assessor of Sabine County, Texas, having completed the Tax Roll for the year of 1920 presented same to the Comm Court for approval after having been examined by the court same was approved by the Court.

It is ordered by the court that Tax Collector be charged \$74,496.94 as Gen Tax and \$642.75 County Poll Tax. Making total Tax of \$75,139.69 and \$16920.00 District School Tax for various school districts for Sabine county, Texas.

The court ordered the Clerk to issue N. A. Williams \$133.00 for painting Court house and Jail roof.

The court ordered that the clerk pay to Tax Assessor the sum of \$681.52 less the amount heretofore paid him as his services as tax assessor in Sabine county, Texas.
