The Court having advertised for bids for a County Depository for Sabine County to act as such for the next two years, etc following bid was filed by the Clerk:-

We submit the following bid, in accordance with you notice in the paper, for the handling of the funds of Sabine County for the next two years.

We will pay 3% interest on average daily balances of Sabins County, all funds belonging to her included, said daily balance to be arrived at by allowing us a daily average credit for County Warrants carried by us.

We agree to carry at per General County and Road and Bridge Warrants up to an amount collected and placed to the credit of each of said General Co, Fund & Bridge Fund for the year 1920. We will pay all school warrants of the County against the State and County apportionment.

All subject to the County keeping with us during the life of this

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agreement, if accepted, the Permanent School Fund.

It is ordered by the Court that the account of Henderson Bros. Lbr Co. for work done on road from Hendersons mill via Wm. Griffins to Hemphill depot for 1/2 of \$727.00 be refused.

It is ordered that all machinery & implements belonging to the County & used in working the roads, shall at all times be kept at the garage built for them at Hemphill when not in actual use on said roads.

It is ordered by the Court that the following charge be granted on the Bronson & Yellow Pine roads as prayed in petition signed by G. M. Tatom & sixteen others on said road:-

Beg. at intersection of Hemphill & Brookeland road at W.C. Connors place Thence in a westerly direction to G. M. Tatoms place; Thence to J. W. Lathoms place; Thence to J. W. Scotts place to the intersection of the Bronson & Yellowpine road.

In pursuance of an order passed by the Court on Janry 10th, 1921, the matter of selling \$20,000.00 Road & Bridge Warrants & \$25,000.00 General Funding Warrants was again taken up & upon a vote of the entire Court on Feby 9th 1921, the following bid of Geo. L. Simpson & Co. of Dallas Texas, was accepted, which is as follows:-

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY JUDGE AND  
COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF  
SABINE COUNTY, HEMPHILL, TEXAS.  
GENTLEMEN:-

For your issue of \$20,000 Road and Bridge Refunding Warrants of Sabine County, Texas to be dated Feb. 15, 1921, and maturing \$2000.00 on March 1st, 1922 and \$2000.00 on March 1st of each year thereafter until paid, bearing interest at the rate of 6% per annum, payable semi-annually on March 1st and Sept. 1st each year, both principal and interest payable at the Continental & Commercial National Bank, Chicago, Illinois we will pay you for said warrants delivered to at Chicago, Illinois, the sum of \$17,000.00.

We agree to prepare all necessary orders to be passed by your Court precedent to and in the issuance of said Warrants, pay our attorneys fees, print suitable blank warrants, and take up and pay for same, immediately upon presentation to us at the Continental & Commercial National Bank, Chicago, together with the complete record and approving legal opinion of W.M. Harris Dallas, Texas.

For your issue of \$25,000.00 Sabine County, Texas General Funding warrants to be dated Feb. 15, 1921, and maturing \$2000.00 March 1st, 1922 and \$2000.00 on March 1st of each year thereafter to and including March 1st, 1932 and \$3000.00 on March 1st, 1933, we agree to pay you the sum of \$21,250.00. We also agree to pay for printing of suitable blank warrants, to prepare all necessary orders, etc. and take up any pay for warrants on delivery to us at the Continental & Commercial National Bank, Chicago, Ill. All warrants to be in the denomination of \$1000.00 each, and bearing interest at the rate of 6% per annum, payable semiannually March 1st and Sept. 1st of each year.

being present, passed the following order by a vote of five votes for its passage to no votes against its passage.

WHEREAS, there are certain county scripts or warrants outstanding and unpaid which are a charge against the Road and Bridge Fund of said County, and this Court, having had under consideration the advisability of extending the time of payment and issuing in lieu thereof interest bearing time warrants, and it appearing to the Court that it is advisable to issue Funding Warrants for the purpose of funding the outstanding script, or warrants, into interest bearing time payment warrants.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS that said warrants of said County, to be called SABINE COUNTY ROAD AND BRIDGE REFUNDING WARRANTS, be issued under and by virtue of the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas for the purpose of refunding an equal amount of warrants of said County duly and legally issued and which are valid, subsisting and not outstanding obligations against said County, the claims for which were duly audited by the Commissioners' Court prior to the issuance of said warrants, and which are cancelled and surrendered, and the warrants herein authorized issued to the holder or holders in lieu thereof, said original outstanding warrants being as follows, to-wit:
