It is ordered by the Court that the Tax Assessor be directed to collect & there is hereby levied the following tax rates on the 100.00 valuation for the year 1921 on all real & personal property in Sabine County as shown by tax rolls.

It is ordered by the Court that the tax rate of .90¢ set aside to take care of the interest & Bonds of the County Road Bonds, be increased to \$1.10 on the 100.00 valuation in order to take care of said interest & coupons & to create a sufficient Sinking fund.

It is ordered by the Court that the County Treasurer is hereby instructed & directed not to pay any more of Smith Bros. accounts or warrants until the State Highway Commission shall have reimbursed Sabine County for all moneys paid by it for account of said Highway Commission on the construction of the Hemphill Geneva highway.

It is ordered by the Court that C. C. Parker be employed as Mechanic at \$100.00 per month to repair, keep up and help run the 2 trucks & tractor to be used in working the roads & highway in Sabine County and to take charge of same at once and do to present repair work necessary in order to put them in first class condition.

It is ordered by the Court that the County officers salaries for the year 1921 be set as follows:
