

ORDER OF COMMISSIONERS' COURT ESTABLISHING ROAD DISTRICT

NO. 8, OF SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS.

THE STATE OF TEXAS.

COUNTY OF SABINE. On this the 12th day of April, A. D. 1921, the County Commissioners court convened in regular session at the regular meeting place thereof in the courthouse at Hemphill, Texas, all the members of said court, to-wit:

A. T. Mathews, Commissioner of Precinct No. 4, being present and passed the following order:

Whereas, a petition signed by H. L. Bradshaw and other persons has this day been presented to this court, praying that bonds be issued in the sum of \$2,000.00 for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating macadamized, graveled or paved roads and turnpikes or in aid thereof, within the territory therein defined, and which said petitioners pray this court to create as a road district, to be known and designated as "Road District No. 8, of Sabine County, Texas," and,

It appearing to the court that said petition bears the requisite number of signatures of resident property taxpaying voters within the proposed road district; and,

It further appearing to the court that it is desirable to establish said road district; and,

It further appearing to the court that the boundaries of said proposed district as described and defined in said petition do not overlap or embrace any part of a political subdivision or defined road district that has heretofore been established and issued road bonds which are now outstanding and unpaid; and,

It further appearing to the court that all the territory to be included within said proposed district is wholly within Sabine county, Texas.

Therefore, be it ordered, adjudged and decreed by the commissioners' court of Sabine County, Texas,

That Road District No. 8, of Sabine County, in the State of Texas, be and the same is hereby established within the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning in said Sabine county, Texas, at the N. W. cor of the James McKim lg., thence S. 41 deg. west with McKim's west line to the southwest cor of said lg.

Thence S. 49 deg. E with S. line of said McKim lg. 512 varas to the N. E. cor of the A. E. C. Johnson lg. where same conflicts with the Samuel Nelson 1/4 lg.

Thence with the east line of said A. E. C. Johnson lg. to its S. E. cor on the bank of McKim creek.

Thence up said McKim creek with its meanders to the east line of the M. Cummings lg.

Thence N. 41 deg. east with the east line of said Cummings lg. to its N. E. cor on the south line of the James McKim lg.

Thence N. 49 deg. W with south line McKim lg. to the S. E. cor of the west 1/2 of said lg.

Thence N. 41 deg. E with divisional line of the McKim lg. to the S. W. cor of the John Brandon 500 acre tract.

Thence S. 49 deg. E with S. line of said Brandon 500 acres 316 varas to the S. W. cor of 247 acres owned by Est. of Alex'r & C. C. Gilmer Deed'd.

Thence N. 76 deg. E. 1619 varas.

Thence N 64 deg. E 370 varas to the N. W. cor. of said Gilmer 247 acres, on north line said
McKin Lg.

Thence S 49 deg. E to the S. E. cor. of the Dan Eastley labor.

Thence N 41 deg. E 510 vrs to the N. W. cor. of the John Saddler survey.

Thence S 49 deg. E 60 varas to the corner of 70 acres of the J. L. Walker survey, owned by
Temple Lbr. Co.

Thence N 86 deg. E 1258 vrs to the E. cor. of said 70 acres.

Thence N 41 deg. E 60 vrs to the most easterly corner of the said J. L. Walker survey.

Thence N 48 deg. W 850 vrs to another cor. said Walker survey.

Thence S 70 deg. W to the S. W. cor. Sec. 33, T & N O Ry. Co.

Thence N 2223 vrs to the N. W. cor. said Sec. 33.

Thence S 69 deg. W with south line J. A. Curry Lg. to the S E cor. of 318 acres owned by
Gilmer est.

Thence N 49 deg. W 870 vrs to N E cor. said 318 acres.

Thence S 60 deg. W with N. line said 318 acres to S. E cor. of 104 acres owned by J. H.
Ragan in the Curry Lg.

Thence N 200 vrs to N E cor. same.

Thence N 72 deg. west 1105 vrs to N. cor. of said 104 acres.

Thence S 33 1/2 deg. west 1475 vrs to west corner of said 104 acres.

Thence with the N. line of said Gilmer 318 acres to its N. W. cor. on N. E. line of Jas. McKin
Lg.

Thence N 49 deg. west with N. E. line McKin League to the place of beginning, and being the
same description of said territory as given in said petition.

That said Road District No. 8 of Sabine county, Texas, is hereby established for the
purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating macadamized, graveled or paved roads and
turnpikes or in aid thereof, within and for said district, under and by virtue of the
Constitution and laws of the State of Texas, including Chapter 2, Title 18, Revised Statutes
1911 as amended by Chapter 203, acts of 1917 regular session and Chapter 18, acts fourth
called session of the Thirty fifth Legislature, and the said district is hereby made and
created a body corporate.

It is further ordered by the court that if the proposition to issue \$2,000.00 road bonds
as prayed for in said petition does not receive a two thirds majority of the vote cast at
the election to be ordered by this court for the purpose of determining whether or not said
bonds shall be issued by said district, then this order shall become wholly null and void but
if said proposition shall receive such necessary favorable vote this order shall then remain
in full force and effect while said bonds, or any of them, are outstanding obligations of
said road district.
