

The Honorable Commissioners Court met in regular session on May, 9th, 1921 with the following members present as follows: to-wit:

The Court was opened by proclamation of the sheriff, G.W. Alford.

The following matters were held together with others, to-wit:

Upon acceptance and approval of town culverts, Murph Flanagan was released and Judge Adams has this day promised to draw draft for 100.00 on Smith Bros. - in favor of Sabine County.

Ordered by the court that duplicate Road and Bridge warrant be issued to Hargis Ener for \$37.75, original dated April 12th, 1921, and lost or misplaced; reg. No. of said original being 6925. -

Ordered that petition of J.H. Bell and others paying for public road to be and extended, beginning at bridge on Bear Creek near J.H. Bell from, on by said Bells house, Thence following the community road leading to Bronson Tram front and intersecting state highway now being constructed from San Augustine to Sabine County line and fully described in said petition and the same is hereby granted.

It is ordered that the quarterly report of L.M. Ritter, County Treasurer, for the quarter ending May, 9th, 1921 has this day been duly examined, approved and received by the court.

Ordered that Road Bond Election be held June 18th, in Road district # 12, embracing Pine-land and Brookland for 60000.00 be and the same is hereby granted.

Ordered that Road Bond Election be held June 18th, in Road district #7, presents by J.C. Busby and other for 15,000.00 be and the same is hereby granted.

Ordered that Road Bond election be held June 18th, in Road District #9 signed by R.W. Carroll and others for \$20000.00 be and the same is hereby granted.

Ordered by the court that the County Treasurer be instructed to transfer from Road Bond fund back to General County fund by proper entry on his books the sum of \$404.25 account error in paying Eld Low said amount June 28th, 1920 out of General County Fund when same should have been paid out of Road Bond fund and that the Clerk also make the proper correction on his finance ledger.

Ordered by the court that the proposition of Gilber Hogan to place 25 cords of oak, pine and gum wood in the court house yard the summer of 1921 @ 4.50 per cord of the size and length and kind agreed upon, be and the same is hereby accepted. -

Ordered by the court that contract be let for approximately \$789.00 for reconstructing and repairing sanitary system in court house and jail building also pool, laying 645 feet 8" pipe, raising water tower and tanks to proper height and also other things not herein mentioned necessary to put said sewer and water system in first class condition, and which are fully set out in contract on file, said work to be passed on and approved by court before being finally accepted.
