

The Honorable Commissioners Court met May 16, 1921, in adjourned session present and presiding; All present except A.T. Methews, and the following proceeding were had.

After canvassing the returns of Road Bond election in Road District no. 4 held at Yellow Pine and Fairmount on May 14th, 1921 for \$140000.00 the following votes were cast:-

At Fairmount 13 for and nothing against.

At Yellow Pine 19 for and 4 against.

Total 32

2/3 majority in favor of issuance of said bond of 28 votes-- Carried

Returns of road bond election held at Pleasant Hill School house, Road Dist. # 5 for 75,000.00 held May 14th, 1921.

For bond 13 votes

against 3

Majority 10 Votes Carried.

A school tax election held in common school district # 12, May 14th, 1921, known as Gomer School House, for school tax election 5/against the increase of school tax 10 votes. It is there fore ordered by the commissioners court that a majority against the increase of school tax, it is further orderd by the court that \$1.00, on the \$100 dollar valuation shall not be levied, assessed and collected.

The returns of an election held May 14, 1921, in common school district No. 6, to determine whether or not said school district should issue said bonds in common school district no. 6 for the purpose of building and equipping a wooden modern school building.

For the Bonds 21 votes, against the bonds 19 votes. There being a majority for said bonds it is there fore ordered by the court that said bond issue be issued and a sinking fund provided for said bond and that a tax for same be assessed, levied and collected in said school district.

May 17th, 1921,

Ordered that a petition for Road Bond Election in road District, # 11, embracing the town of Hemphill, for 60,000.00 be and the same is hereby granted, said election to be held on June 18th, 1921.

Convas of election returns Road Dist. # 6 held at Hemphill colored school house May 14, 1921, as follows for the bonds 14 against the bonds 1- carried for \$45,000.00.

Convas of election returns in common school dist. # 16- Gravel Hill- shows For the bond 17- against 3- held on May 14, 1921.

Convas of school bond election returns in common school dist. # 14 held May 14th at Pinehill shows: for bond 10, against 9- Carried.
