

The Hon. Commissioners Court, Meetin regular session July 11, 1921, with the following members present as follows to wit:

The court was opened by the Sheriff G.W. Alford and the following matters were had together with others to wit:

It is ordered by the court that the matter of working the county convicts be suspended until a better plan or system is inaugurated by which there will be a containment of expenses and the county will derive more benefit for money expended and incurred account of working him under its present system.

It is ordered that the services of Oliver McElroy are hereby dispensed with.

It is ordered by the court that the work of D.L. London on jail and court house and building new sewer line after having been inspected is hereby accepted and the balance or \$344.00 due him on his contract of \$959.80 be paid him.

Be it remembered, that a regular session of the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, held at the Court house in said County on the second Monday in July, 1921, same being the 11th day of said month with W.C. Arnold, County Judge, present and presiding, J.A. Ragan, Commissioner of Precinct No. 1, J.M. Ball, Commissioner of Precinct No. 2, S.H. Hall, Commissioner of Precinct No. 3, and A.T. Matthews, Commissioner of Precinct No. 4, S.W. Bright County Clerk and G.W. Alford, Sheriff, all being present Court was duly opened and the following order was passed by the court, all members of the court being present, to-wit:

It is ordered by the court that there be levied, assessed and collected on all of the taxable property in Sabine County, for the year 1921, the following taxes:

For general County purposes, twenty five cents on the one hundred dollars valuation.

For the jury fund, fifteen cents on the one hundred dollars valuation.

For roads and bridges, fifteen cents on the one hundred dollars valuation.

For the erection of public buildings, street, sewer, water works and other permanent improvements, twenty five cents on the one hundred dollar's valuation.

For County road bond fund one dollar and twenty cents on the one hundred dollar valuation.

And the County Assessor of Sabine County is hereby authorized to make up his tax rolls for the year 1921 at the above rates.

It is further ordered that an occupation tax in the sum of one half of the State occupation tax is hereby levied on all occupations taxed by the State of Texas and the Tax Collector of Sabine County is hereby authorized to collect such occupation taxes.
