

The Honorable Commissioner Court met in regular session Oct., 10, 1921 with the following members present as follows:

The court was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff G.W. Alford.

The following matters had together to-wit:

It is ordered that in as much as Mr. Johnson County Agent has tendered his resignation unconditionally thereby ending his contract with the county as such the county feels that it is thereby released from its obligation and that the matter of employing a county agent to fill out the unexpired time of Mr. Johnson terminated and of no further force and effect and that the Clerk is hereby directed that he issue no warrant to any successors of Mr. Johnson.

It is ordered by the court that the delinquent Tax roll for Sabine County, be published in the Hemphill paper to begin - the first issue to appear during the week including October the 15th, 1921 and to continue for four successive weeks thereafter said first publication to be included during the week of Oct. 15th, 1921.

It is ordered that the resignation of W.V. McElroy as Justice of the Peace Precinct No. 2 Sabine County is hereby accepted and that Jeff Finn be appointed in his place conditioned that he qualify and give the necessary bond as required by law.

It is ordered by the court that the bond for \$1250.00 be and the same are hereby approved.

It is ordered by the court that the bonds for common School district no. 14 in amount of \$1500.00 be and the same are hereby approved.

It is ordered by the court that Lucelle Jacks an indigent person receive aid at the rate of \$10.00 per month beginning to-day Oct., 10th as county aid.

Upon a vote taken by the court that the order passed this morning relative to discontinuing the services of a county Agent and after canvassing said vote it was found that A.T. Mathews, W.C. Arnold, and S.H. Hall voted for the continuation of an agent and J. M. Ball and J.A. Ragan voted against continuing county agent.

It is therefore ordered that said agent is hereby employed up to January 1st, 1922.
