

The Hon. Commissioners court met in Regular session Nov. 14, 1921, with the following members present as follows, to wit:

The court was opened by proclamation of Sheriff G. W. Alford.

The following matters were had together with others, whereas the proposition of retaining the Live Stock Inspector for County, was taken up and was ordered stopped by order of the court. J. A. Ragan, J. M. Ball and W. C. Arnold voted against the continuing the work and S. H. Hall and A. T. Matthews voted for the order.

It is ordered by the court that the quarterly report of Mrs. L. M. Ritter, County Treasurer, for the quarter ending Nov. 14th 1921, be and the same is hereby approved.

It is ordered by the court that the county contribute \$100.00 towards improving the Hemphill Streets as soon as it shall have received the money due it by the State Account construction Hemphill-Geneva highway.

It is ordered by the court that T. B. Hamilton, County Attorney is hereby instructed to immediately proceed with the filing of all delinquent tax suits for the enforcement and collection of all delinquent taxes now due the county & state as shown by all the delinquent years, and further that J. G. Barker county surveyor, is hereby authorized to assist the said T. B. Hamilton in the way of properly getting up the field notes embracing and describing the lands or property upon which all delinquent taxes are now due.

And it is further ordered that said Barker be allowed as compensation for such services the sum of \$300.00, \$150.00 in cash, and the balance upon the filing and completion of such suits; and further that the said Hamilton & Barker proceed with the filing of said delinquent tax suits and collection of said taxes at once.

It is ordered that old man John Holmes be allowed \$10.00 per month as county aid and that same be delivered to Bob Boyd.

Whereas, the death of L. M. Ritter, County Treasurer of Sabine county, having been suggested to the court, and in pursuance of Art. 1303 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Texas, it is incumbent upon the Commissioners Court to appoint a successor to fill out the unexpired term of the said L. M. Ritter; and upon application of all parties making application for said appointment, Mrs. L. M. Ritter was duly appointed to fill out the unexpired term of said L. M. Ritter by a unanimous vote of the court conditioned upon the said Mrs. L. M. Ritter qualifying and executing the necessary bond as required by law.

There being no further business to come before the court, the court adjourned.
