

The Hon. Commissioners Court met in regular session Jan. 9th, 1922.

The court was opened by proclamation of the Sheriff, G. W. Alford.

It is ordered by the court that Clarence Chappel an indigent person be allowed \$10.00 per month county aid until further notified.

It is ordered that Smith Bros. be paid the sum of \$742.30, being balance due them in full for \$2848.10 net ft. guard rail @ 30% less 112.10, on Hemphill, Geneva highway.

It is ordered that County aid extended to Jake Woodard be cut down from \$15.00 to \$10.00 per month beginning from this date and that Mrs. Ola Chance an indigent person with 4 little children be allowed \$15.00 per month, beginning Jan. 1st 1922.

The account of Mr. & Mrs. Knox for timber cut and removed on Hemphill, Fairdale highway in amount \$1802.00 having been presented to the court for payment, and after Mrs. Knox had agreed to take for immediate acceptance \$1000.00 for said claim, thereupon the court took a vote as to whether they would allow the account and same was wholly turned down and refused.

It is ordered that 50 acres of the Wright Coley survey now on rendition roll of Kirby Lumber Co. be eliminated from said rendition as it appears they did not own same on Jan. 1st 1921.

It is ordered by the court that the account of Austin Brothers Bridge Co. for \$6429.93 be and the same is hereby allowed for bridges on Hemphill, Geneva highway less \$790.00 account work done by county forces on grade and channel under Boragin, Causey and Pologocho creeks and that voucher issue to them for \$5639.93.

It is ordered by the court that an agreement has been entered into by said commissioners to the effect and whereby the Road Bond fund reverting back to the county on account of not being used on Hemphill, Geneva highway is to be divided and pro-rated share and share alike divided into four equal parts between the four commissioners and by them to be used in the construction, building of other roads in their respective commissioners beats.

It is ordered that rendition for 1921 of Abst. No. 159 and being 144 acres of the Jas. Mason Labor on account of Errors in assessment belonging to Mrs. M. A. Carter be and the same is hereby corrected to read \$580.00 instead of \$1150.00 as shown by Tax Rolls for 1921.

Accounts were allowed as per ledger.

Court adjourned till next regular meeting.
