The following matters were had together with others viz:

It is ordered by the court that County demonstration work for 1922 be continued and after taking a vote on same, A. T. Matthews, S. H. Hall & W. C. Arnold voted for same and J. M. Ball and J. A. Ragan voted against it. It is therefore ordered that demonstration work be put on for another year.

It is ordered by the court that Crckett Travis be appointed Live inspector for the balance of the year at \$75.00 per month up until April 1st 1922 & 100.00 during period from April 1st until Oct. 1st 1922 and \$75.00 during Oct. Nov. Dec. 1922.

It is ordered by the court that the account of William Cooper and Nephews for 2350 gallons dip amounting to \$3407.50 be deferred on payment for another six month for the reason that there is a deficiency in the General County Fund and it has become necessary to take this step as the county has not the money and we must as this indebtedness of said Company, by paying 6% interest on said accounts.

Accounts were allowed as per ledger.
