The Board of Equalizers adjourned the 25th day of May and convened as a Comm. Court to attend to court matters:

It is ordered by the court that the check No. 889 issued to E. A. Chambers out of R. & B. be cancelled and be issued out of Gen. Co. dated Oct. 11, 1921.

It is therefore ordered by the court that the Board of Equalization be recessed until the 13th day of June A. D. 1922, it therefore ordered that to show causes why property should not be raised will be heard.

It is ordered by the court that its action in asking extension of six months time of William Cooper & Nephews on account for \$3611.95 be cancelled and rescinded, and in lieu thereof <sup>and</sup> warrant for said amount of \$3611.95 be issued as per Mr. McElroy's suggestion and not due and payable until Feb. 1st 1923, as interest and principal will not have accumulated to this amount until said Feb. 1st 1923.

Canvassing Returns and Declaring Result of Election

At a meeting of the commissioners court of the County of Sabine State of Texas, held on the 16th day of May, A. D. 1921, came on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 14th day of May, 1921, to determine whether or not the bonds of Road District No. 4, of Sabine County, Texas, should be issued to the amount of One Hundred and forty thousand (\$140,000.00) Dollars, bearing interest at the rate of five and one-half (5½) per cent per annum payable not to exceed thirty years from date, for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating macadamized, gravelled or paved roads and turnpikes, or in aid thereof and whether or not a tax shall be annually levied, assessed and collected in said Road District No. 4, of Sabine County, Texas, sufficient to pay the current interest on said bonds and to provide the required sinking fund to redeem them at maturity, and it appearing that said election was in all respects lawfully held and said returns duly and legally made and that there were cast at said election 36 votes, of which number 32 votes were cast "For the issuance of bonds and the levying of the tax in payment thereof," and 4 votes cast "Against the issuance of bonds and levying of the tax in payment thereof."

It is therefore ordered and declared that the proposition to issue said bonds and levy said tax was sustained by a two-thirds majority of the qualified property taxpayers voting at said election, and that the commissioners court of the said County is authorized

Canvassing Returns and Declaring Result of Election:

At a meeting of the commissioners court of Sabine County, Texas, held on the 16th day of May, A. D. 1921, came on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 14th day of May, 1921, to determine whether or not the bonds of Road District No. 5, of Sabine County, Texas, should be issued to the amount of Seventy Five Thousand (\$75,000.00) Dollars, bearing interest at the rate of five and one half (5½) per cent per annum payable not to exceed thirty years from date, for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating macadamized, graveled or paved roads and turnpikes, or in aid thereof, and whether or not a tax shall be annually levied, assessed and collected in said Road District No. 5, of Sabine County, Texas, sufficient to pay the current interest on said bonds and to provide the required sinking fund to redeem them at maturity, and it appearing that said election was in all respects lawfully held, and said returns duly and legally made, and that there were cast at said election 16 votes, of which number 13 votes were cast "For the issuance of bonds and levying of the tax in payment thereof," and 3 votes cast "Against the issuance of bonds and levying of the tax in payment thereof."

It is therefore ordered and declared that the proposition to issue said bonds and levy said tax was sustained by a two thirds majority of the qualified property tax payers voting at said election, and that the commissioners court of the said County is authorized to issue said bonds, and to levy and have assessed and collected said tax.

Canvassing Returns and Declaring Result of Election:

At a meeting of the commissioners court of Sabine county, Texas, held on the 16th day of May, A.D. 1921, came on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 14th day of May, 1921, to determine whether or not the bonds of Road District No. 6, of Sabine County, Texas, should be issued to the amount of Forty Five Thousand (\$45,000.00) Dollars bearing interest at the rate of five and one-half (5½) per cent per annum, payable not to exceed thirty years from date, for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating macadamized, graveled or paved roads and turnpikes, or in aid thereof, and whether or not a tax shall be annually levied, assessed and collected in said Road District No. 6, of Sabine County, Texas, sufficient to pay the current interest on said bonds and to provide the required sinking fund to redeem them at maturity, and it appearing that said election was in all respects lawfully held and said returns duly and legally made, and that there were cast at said election 15 votes of which number 14 votes were cast "For the issuance of bonds and levying of the tax in payment thereof," and 1 vote cast "Against the issuance of bonds and levying of the tax in payment thereof."

It is therefore ordered and declared that the proposition to issue said bonds and levy said tax was sustained by a two-thirds majority of the qualified property taxpayers voting at said election, and that the commissioners court of the said County is authorized to issue said bonds, and to levy and have assessed and collected said tax.
