It is ordered by the Court that Jack Whittlesey be awarded the contract to furnish the County 30 cords of wood of Oak & Pine of all Length at \$2.70 per cord to be stacked on Court Yard.

It is ordered by the Court that the general County fund be reimbursed out of the Jury Fund to the amount of \$9.00 for payment out of General County Fund when same should have been paid out of Jury Fund same being three Jurors at \$3.00 each.

It is ordered that the quarterly report of Mrs. L. M. Ritter Co. Treasurer for the quarter ending August, 14th, 1922, be and the same is hereby in all things approved.

It is ordered by the Court that Albert Carter help be increased, from \$10.00 to \$15.00 per month until further notified.

It is ordered by the Court that County Aid be extended to Green Randle to the amount of \$10.00 per month, beginning Augst 1st, 1922, until further notified.

It is ordered by the Court that County aid be extended to Amanda Grant, in the sum of \$10.00 per month, same beginning August 1st, 1922, until further notified.

It is ordered by the Court that the County pay the expenses of W. A. French Co, Engineer of San Augustine, County to Austin for purpose of going before and taking up with highway department the matter of obtaining State aid on certain roads & projects in Sabine County to be enumerated by him.

It is ordered by the Court, that the resignation of J. L. Ludlow as Justice of the Peace Bronson be accepted & that Rev. Windham be appointed in his place conditioned that he qualify according to law.

Wherefore apertition has been presented to the Court signed by the proper number of signers praying that there be created an election precinct to be known as Election Precinct Number 15, of Sabine County, Texas, signed by T. A. Harris, and Sixty one other qualified voters in said precinct and described by metes and bounds as follows:

It is ordered by the Court that said Election Precinct No. 15, be and is hereby in all things granted & that a Copy of this be published for three successive weeks in the Hemphill Reporter.

We, the undersigned being resident citizens within the herein described territory situated in Sabine County, Texas, respectfully represent:

First That we desire your Hon. body to create an election precinct to be known as "Election Precinct No. 16," with a voting box, at the School house in said district, which is located on the Hemphill and San Augustine Highway.

Second That the territory which we pray your Honorable body to designate as "Voting Precinct No. 16" of Sabine County, Texas, has the same metes and bounds as Com. School District No. 16, to-wit:

Beginning at the S. E. corner of the Wm. Clark.

Thence westerly to South east corner of a 1454 acre survey, made for Spencer Ashmore.

Thence North to the N. E. corner of said 1454 acres on Tebo Creek.

Thence up said creek to west line of said Clark.

Thence South to S. E. corner of Joseph Mott.

Thence westerly to N. E. corner of Anna Giles Pre-emption.

Thence Southerly westerly & Northerly with line of said Giles to N. W. corner of Wm. Donahoe Labore.

Thence Southerly-Westerly-Northerly & Easterly with line of Donahoe to corner of Joseph Mott survey.

Thence N. W. with line of said Mott to his corner on Wm. Isaac.

Thence Easterly & Northerly with said Isaac line to S. W. corner of the N. Mackie.

Thence E. with the S. line of said Mackie to the Polo Gocho and down the Polo Gocho Creek to the N. W. line of the Wm. Clark.

Thence N. E. along Clarks line to S. W. corner of the C. Boyett Pre-emption.

Thence E. along the S. line of said Boyett to its S. E. corner and continuing the same course along the south line of the Walker to N. E. corner of the Wm. Clark.

Thence South-Southeast and south along Clarks E. line to Pologoché to mouth of Tebo Creek.

Thence up said Tebo Creek to Wm. Clarks E. line to place of beginning.

County of Sabine. To the Honorable Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas;

We, the undersigned being resident citizens within the herein described territory situated in Sabine County, Texas, respectfully represents:

First. That we desire your Honorable body to create an election precinct, to be known as "Election Precinct No. 15", with a voting Box at what is now known as Strickland Chappel, which is located on the L. H. & G. Rai road, about halfway between Hemphill and Bronson, Texas.

Second. That the territory which we pray your Honorable body to designate as "Voting Precinct No. 15, of Sabine County, Texas, is accurately described by metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning in said Sabine County, Texas, at the most Northern corner of Mary J. Brumley survey.

Thence S. 58 E. with the N. E. line of the M. J. Brumley Survey to its N. E. corner.

Thence S. 5 E. with M. J. Brumley's East line to its S. E. corner.

Thence S. 32 W. with the S. E. line of the M. J. Brumley to its most southern corner

Thence S. 58 E. with the N. line of the H. S. White 120 vrs. to its N. E. corner.

Thence S. 32 W. with the S. E. line of the H. S. White, survey to its most southerly corner on the N. line of the Robert H. Smith. survey.

Thence S. 15 W. about 300 vrs to the N. E. corner of a 120 acre-subdivision owned by W. R. Davidson.

Thence N. 75 W. with W. R. Davidson's N. line to the N. W. corner of Davidson's 120 acre sub-division.

Thence S. 5 E. 189 vrs. with the W. B. line of said W. R. Davidson's 120 acre-subdivision to the N. line of a 100 acre subdivision of said Robert H. Smith owned by W. R. Davidson.

Thence S. 5 E. with John Clark's East league line to the Housen Bayou.

Thence in a Westerly direction with the Housen Bayou to the mouth of Watts Creek.

Thence in a Westerly direction up the Watts Creek with its meanders to the west line of a 200 acre sub-division owned by H. W. Huffman.

Thence N. 6 W. with the West line of said 200 acre sub-division to the S. E. corner of a 190 acre sub-division owned by T. G. Fuller, same being the N. E. corner of the J. A. Travis 100 acres.

Thence west with the N. line of J. A. Travis 100 acres 674 vrs. to the S. E. corner of a 10 acre-sub-division owned by J. A. Travis,

Thence N. 6 W. with the East line of said 10 acre sub-division 155 vrs to its N. E. corner.

Thence west with the N. line of said J. A. Travis 10 acres 360 vrs. to its N. W. corner on the divisional line of the John Clark League.

Thence S. 6 E. with the divisional line of the John Clark League to the Watts Creek.

Thence in a westerly direction up Watts Creek with its meanders to the west line of the John Clark League, same being the east line of the John Gilbert League.

Thence S. 5 E. with the East line of the John Gilbert League to the N. E. corner of a sub-division on the John Gilbert League known as Block No. 6.

Thence S. 85 W. with the N. line of Block No. 6, Block No. 5, Block No. 4, to the N. W. corner of Block No. 4.

Thence S. 5 E. with the west line of Block No. 4m to the N. E. corner of the B. V. Jones 151 acre sub-division.

Thence S. 85 W. with B. V. Jones N. line to the N. W. corner of said B. V. Jones 151 acres 102 vrs to the N. E. corner of the W. T. Jones 100 acre sub-division.

Thence westerly 120 vrs. to Yellowpine and Bronson Public road. Thence West-erly with said road to the Plainview School House. Thence Easterly with the Lower Hemphill and Homer road by Tom Pulliam's place to the seven mile post on said road from Hemphill Texas. Thence Northerly to the six mile post on the Hemphill and Bronson Highway from Hem-phil, Texas. Thence Easterly said Hemphill and Bronson Highway to place of beginning.
