The Resignation of W. R. Davidson as J. P. of Precinct No. 1, having been tendered the Court by letter same is hereby excepted and W. H. Pratt, is appointed by the Court to fill out the unexpired Term of said W. R. Davidson. The Resignation of S. B. Glawson as Constable of Precinct No. 1 in Sabine Co, Texas, having been tendered by letter same, is hereby excepted, and R. W. Baldree is hereby appointed to fill out the unexpired term of S. B. Glawson as Constable Precinct No. 1.

Question of assisting the people in building Vats to the extent of buying the Cement, W. C. Arnold, S. H. Hall, A. T. Mathews, voted for same and J. A. Ragan having voted against same it is therefore ordered by the Court that the County assist the people to extent of buying the Cement. It is ordered by the Court that time be paid out of the Road Bond Fund \$1200.72 in to the General County Fund, an account of money expended out of the General County Fund in Maintaining High-way.

It is ordered that J. W. Minton be allowed \$50.00 as Expense money for trip to Austin in the matter of District Road Bonds same to be paid out of Permanent Improvement Fund.

It is ordered by the Court that the matter of helping build Vats in the County be and the same is hereby rescribed as the cement costs entirely too much and the funds of the County are exhausted and not able to pay for any part of same.

The resignation of C. C. Parker as County road Mechanic, having been tendered same is hereby accepted.
