


At meeting of the Comissioners.Court of the County of Sabine, State of Texas, held on the 10 th day of Noveriber 1922 came on to be considered the seturns of an election held on the 28th day of October 1922, to determine whether or not the bonds of Road District No. 7, of Sabine County, Texas, shouid be issued to the amount of olis;000.00, bearing finterest at the rate of five and one-hal per cent, per anum, payabe thitrty years from date, for the purpose of constructing maintaining and aperating macadamized, graveded or paved roads and turnpikes, or in ald thereof and whether on not a tax shal be annuany, Ievied, assessed añ collected, in said Road District No, of Sabine County, Texas, sufficient to pay the current interest them at maturity, año it appearing that said election was in all regpects lawfully helf, and said teturn duly and agaly made, and that there were, ca at said election 6 votes, of which number 5 votes were cast "For the issuance of borids iand
 and levying of the tax in"payment thereof."

It is therefore ordered and declared that the proposition to issue said bonds and levy said tax wés sustained by two-thirds majority of the qualified property tax-ict payers voting at said election, and that the Comissioneñs Court of the said County is auth orized to issue said, bonds', and to lèvy and have aṣsessed, and collected said tax.

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## Canvassing Returns and Declaring Resuly of Election.

At a meeting of the Comisisioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, held, on the loth day of November, 1922 , came on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 28th day of $0_{c}$ tober 1922, to determine whether or not the bonds of Road District No ge, of then Sabine County, Texas, shoudl be issued to the amount of $\$ 20,000.00$ bearing interest at the rate of five and one-haleper cent per annum payable thirty years from dates fortherpurn pose of constrūcting, maintaining and operating macadamized, graveled or paved roads and. turnpikes, or in aid thereof, and, whether or not a tax shall be annually leviedj Essessed and collected in said Road District No, 9, of Sabine County, Texas, sufficient to pay, the current interest on saíd bonds and to, provude the required sinking fund to redeem them att maturity, and it appearing that said ejection was in alp respects lawfuliy held, and sadis teturns duly and legally made, and that there were cast at said election 60 votes of of which number 48 votes were cast, "For the issuance of bonds and levying of trie tex in payment thereof," and 12 votes "Against, the issuance of bonds and levying of the tax in pay-" ment thereof: $\because$

It is therefore ordered and deciared that, the proposition to isisue said bonds and levy said tax was sustained by a two thirds majority of the qualified, property taxpayers voting at said election, and that the Comissioners Court of the said County is. authorized to issue said bonds, and to levy and have assessed and colected said tax.

To the Honorable Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, Texas:
We, the undersigned, being resident cittans within the hereinafter described territory situated in $S_{a b i n e}$ County, Texas, respectfully represent.

First. That we are resident property taxpaying voters within said territory.
Second. That we desire your Honorable body to order on election to determine whether or not the bonds of said territory; to be known and designated as "Road Distriett"

No. 10, of Sabine County Texas. in shatiferssued in the amout of Ninety Thousand Doilars bearing five per cent rate of interest, Jand maturing at such times as may be fixed by, the Comaissioners! Courterially or otherwise not to exceed thirty years from date thereof, for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating macadamized, gravied or paved roads and turnpikes, or, in aid thereof; and whether or not a tax shall be levied upon the property of said proposed, road district; pubject to taxation, for the purpose of paying the interest on said bonds and to provide ainking fund for the redemption thereof at maturity.

The proveedg of sald bonds to be used in the following menner:
(1) $\$ 12,000$ on that part of the road running East end West through the town of Brookeland which iies within said district.
(2) $\$ 3000.00$ on that portion of the femphil and Tebo roading, within said district.
(3) 5000.00 than part of the road ruming Fast and West through Bronson which lies within said district.

(4) $\$ 3000.00$ on that portion of the road running Fast and West through the tovm of pineland which lies within aid district.
(5) $\$ 67,000$ on on the pubic foad leading from the County line of Sabine county just West of the town of Tebo by way of Tebo, Bronson, Pineland and Brockeland to the County line of Jesper Cóuntyi

Third. That, the territory whichrwe pray your Honorable body to designate as "Road District No. 10 , of Sapine Countyp Texas," is accurately described by metes and bounds tö-wit:
