

The Honorable Commissioner's Court, Convened in Regular Session January 8, 1923,

The Commissioners Court ordered the payment of the account of Von Beckmann Jones Company, for printing Road Bonds Districts Number One, two, three, four, five and six. Each account to be allowed out of its District.

Ordered by the Court that the County Treasurer transfer from the Jury Fund to the Road Bond Sinking Fund the amount of \$500.00.

Ordered by the Court that the County Treasurer accept the sum of \$3.00 from each road hand subject to road duty which amount is to be paid on or before Feby. 1, 1923. And if later date the sum of \$5.00 the amount collected is to be placed to the account of the Commissioner in whose precinct collected.

The Honorable Commissioners Court convened in regular session Jan. 9th 1923.

On motion of A. F. Vickers seconded by J. A. Ragan. The commissioners court passed an order that all the County and Precinct Officers shall pay for all Stationary used in their respective offices, except legal blanks and books, which are necessary in keeping the Records of their office. That each Officer pay for their Typewriter Ribbons, And wood, All the Court Voted Aye.

On motion of J. A. Ragan Seconded by J. M. Ball, that the Court vote to see if the County Agriculture Agent should be retained for the year of 1923. S. H. Hall, voted Aye, J. A. Ragan, A. F. Vickers, and J. M. Ball Voted. No.

On Motion of J. M. Ball, Seconded by J. A. Ragan, as to whether or not we should carry on the work of the Live-Stock Inspector at the present time, J. A. Ragan, J. M. Ball, and A. F. Vickers, Voted No. and S. H. Hall. Aye.

Court adjourned until next regular meeting.

COUNTY ROAD AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION.

Sealed proposals addressed to W. H. Davidson, County Judge for the improvement of certain County Highways in Sabine County, will be received at the office of W. H. Davidson at Hemphill, Texas, until 12 o'clock P. M. March 3, 1923, and then publicly open and read.

Approximate quantities are as follows: Clearing 66 acres, grubbing 66 acres; Unclassified excavation 44000 cu Yds. Gravel hauled, placed etc. 1st. 1/4 mi. 17424 Cu. Yds. Gravel hauled additional 1/4 mi. 87120 Cu. Yds. Untreated bridge lumber in place (County to furnish material) 40 62FBM. 90% heart post oak lumber for culverts in place (County to furnish material) 4.03FBM.
