

The State of Texas | Order Authorizing the issuance of Bonds:
County of Sabine | On this the 12th day of March, A. D. 1923, the Commissioners Court
convened in regular Session at the regular meeting place thereof in the Courthouse at
Hemphill, Texas, all members of the Court, to-wit:

following order:

Whereas, on the 12th day of May, A. D. 1921, there was presented to this Court a
petition signed by the requisite number of qualified resident property tax paying voters of
Road District No. 7, of Sabine County, Texas, praying that an election be ordered to determine
whether or not the bonds of said Road District No. 7, of Sabine County, Texas, shall be issued
in the amount of \$15,000.00 bearing 5% percent rate of interest, for the purpose of construct-
ing, maintaining and operating macadamized, graveled or paved roads and turnpikes, within and
thereof, within and for said district, and the levy of a tax upon the property of said district
subject to taxation, for the purpose of paying the interest on said bonds and to provide a
sinking fund for the redemption thereof at maturity; and,

Whereas, this Court, pursuant to said petition on the 11th day of September, 1922,
ordered that an election be held throughout said district on the 28th day of October, 1922, as
prayed for; and,

Whereas, notice of said election was given by publication in the Sabine County
Reporter, a newspaper published in said County (there being no newspaper in said district)
and which notice was published for four consecutive weeks next prior to the date of said
election, and, in addition thereto, notice thereof was posted at three public places in said
district, for at least three weeks next preceding the date of said election, one of which was

posted at the Old Tim Edgar House, the polling place; and
Whereas, said election was duly and legally held on the said 28th day of October, 1922, and the result of said election was duly certified and returned to this Court by the Judges and Clerks thereof; and,

Whereas, on the 10th day of November, 1922, this Court considered the several returns and canvassed the same, and found, that there were cast at said election 5 votes, of which number 5 votes were cast "For the issuance of bonds and the levying of the tax in payment thereof", and no votes were cast "Against the issuance of Bonds and the levying of the tax in payment thereof"; and this Court thereupon, by order duly entered, declared that the proposition so submitted was sustained and adopted by a two-thirds majority vote of the qualified resident property tax payers voting at said election; and,

Whereas, this Court has examined unto and investigated the regularity of the proceedings for said election and finds that the same was duly and legally held; that the notice required by law to be given has been duly and legally given; and that said election was conducted in strict conformity with all the requirements of law;

THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas.

II.

That the bonds of said Road District No. 7, of Sabine County, Texas, to be known as "Road Bonds of Road District No. 7, of Sabine County, Texas," be issued on the faith and credit of said Road District No. 7, of Sabine County, Texas, under and by virtue of Articles 627 to 641, inclusive, of Chapter 2, Title 18, Revised Statutes, 1911, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 203, Acts of 1917, Regular Session,

III.

That said bonds are issued for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating macadamized, graveled or paved roads and turnpikes, or in aid thereof, within and for said Road District No. 7, of Sabine County, Texas.

IV.

That said bonds shall be numbered consecutively from One to Twenty, inclusive, and shall be of the denomination of Five hundred (\$500.00) Dollars each, aggregating Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars.

V.

That said bonds shall be dated the first day of March, A. D. 1923, and shall become due and payable serially according to the following schedule:

That said bonds shall bear interest at the rate of five and one-half ($5\frac{1}{2}$) per centum per annum payable semi-annually, on March 1st and September 1st of each year and principal and interest shall be payable upon presentation and surrender of bonds or proper coupon in lawful money of the United States of America at the First National Bank of Hemphill, at Hemphill, Texas, or at the Hanover National Bank in New York City, New York, at the option of the holder.

VI.

That each of said bonds shall be signed by the County Judge, countersigned by the County Clerk, and registered by the County Treasurer, and the seal of the Commissioners Court shall be impressed upon each of them.

VII.

That the facsimile signatures of the County Judge and the County Clerk shall be lithographed or printed on the coupons attached to said bonds, and shall have the same effect as if they had been signed by them.

That the form of each of said bonds shall be substantially as follows:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Road District No. 7, of Sabine County, Texas, for value received, acknowledges itself indebted to and hereby promises to pay to bearer FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS,

in lawful money of the United States of America, on the first day of March, 19_____, with interest thereon from date hereof, at the rate of five and one-half per centum per annum, payable on the first day of March and September in each year, on presentation and surrender of the annexed interest coupons as they severally mature.

Both principal and interest of this bond are hereby made payable at the First National Bank of Hemphill, at Hemphill, Texas, or at the Hanover National Bank in New York City, New York, at the option of the holder, and for the prompt payment of this bond and the interest thereon at maturity, the full faith, credit and resources of Road District No. 7, of Sabine County, Texas, are hereby irrevocably pledged.

This bond is one of a series of TWENTY bonds numbered consecutively from 1 to 20, inclusive, of the denomination of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, each, aggregating Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars, issued for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating macadamized, graveled or paved roads and turnpikes, or in aid thereof, under and in strict conformity with the Constitution and Laws of the State of Texas, including Articles 627, to 641, inclusive, of Chapter 2, Title 18, Revised Statutes, 1921, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 203, Acts of 1917, Regular session, and pursuant to an order passed by the

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Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, on the 12th day of March, A. D. 1933, which order
is of record in Book M, pages 12, et seq., of the Minutes of said Court.

The date of this bond, in conformity with the order above mentioned is March 1st, 1923.

AND IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED AND RECITED that the issuance of this bond, and the series of which it is a part, is duly authorized by law and by a two-thirds majority of the qualified resident property tax paying voters of Road District No. 7, of Sabine County, Texas, voting at an election duly held for that purpose within said District on the 28th day of October, 1923; that all acts, conditions and things required to be done precedent to and in the issuance of this series of bonds, and of this bond, have been properly done and performed and have happened in regular and due time, "form and manner as required by law; that a direct annual tax has been levied upon all taxable property in the said district sufficient to pay the interest on this bond and the principal thereof at maturity; and that the total indebtedness of said District, including this bond does not exceed any Constitutional or Statutory limitation.

It is further ordered, that while said bonds, or any of them, are outstanding and unpaid, there shall be, and it is hereby ordered that there be, levied and assessed and collected, in due time, form and manner, and at the time other County taxes are levied, assessed and collected, in each year, a tax upon all the taxable property in said Road District No. 7, of Sabine County, Texas, sufficient to pay the current interest thereon and to pay each installment of the principal as the same becomes due, and to pay the interest on said bonds and the principal to become due the first year, there is hereby levied a tax of One Hundred and Fifty Cents of Cents on each One Hundred Dollars valuation of taxable property in said Road District for the year 1923; and the same shall be assessed and collected and applied to the purposes named.

XII.

IT IS ALSO ORDERED that W. H. Davidson, County Judge of Sabine County, be authorized to take and have charge of all necessary records pending investigation by the Attorney General, and shall take and have charge and control of the bonds herein authorized pending their approval by the Attorney General and registration by the Comptroller of Public Accounts.

\$16,000.00 Road and Bridge warrants bearing six per cent, dated February 15th 1921, payable \$2000.00 annually on March 1st.

\$6000.00 Road and bridge warrants, bearing six per cent interest dated December 1st 1915, payable \$2000.00 annually.

\$21,000.00 General County Warrants, bearing six per cent interest dated February 15th 1921, payable \$2000.00 annually and \$3000.00 in 1933.

There was no indebtedness of any kind existing against Road District No. 7, of Sabine County, Texas, on the 12th day of March, A. D. 1923.

The total value of real property in Sabine County as shown by the Tax Rolls for 1922, is \$3,667,095.00.

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PETITION TO THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FOR ROAD DISTRICT

BONDS AND FOR CREATION OF ROAD DISTRICT NUMBER 8,

SABINE COUNTY, TEXAS.

State of Texas,

County of Sabine To the Honorable Commissioners Court of Sabine County:

We, the undersigned, being resident citizens within the hereinafter described territory situated in Sabine County, Texas, respectfully represent:

First. That we are resident property tax paying voters within said territory.

Second. That we desire your Honorable body to order and election to determine whether or not the bonds of said territory, to be known and designated as "Road District No. 8, of Sabine County, Texas," shall be issued in the amount of \$2,000.00, bearing five and one half per cent rate of interest, and maturing at such times as may be fixed by the Commissioners Court, serially or otherwise, not to exceed thirty years from date thereof, for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating macadamized, graveled or paved roads and turnpikes, or in aid thereof; and whether or not a tax shall be levied upon the property of said proposed road district, subject to taxation, for the purpose of paying the interest on said bonds and to provide a sinking fund for the redemption thereof at maturity.

WHEREAS, a petition signed by H. L. Bradshaw and 9 other persons, has this day been presented to this Court, praying that bonds be issued in the sum of \$2,000.00 for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating macadamized, graveled or paved roads and turnpikes, or in aid thereof, within the territory therein defined and which said petitioners pray this court to create as a road district, to be known and designated as "Road District No. 8, of Sabine County, Texas;" and,

Thence with the N. line of said Gilmer 318 acres to its N. W. cor. on N.E. line of Jas. McKim Lg.


Thence N. 49 deg. west with N. E. line McKim League to the place of beginning, and being the same description of said territory as given in said petition.



That said Road District No. 8, of Sabine County, Texas, is hereby established for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating macadamized, graveled or paved roads and turnpikes, or in aid thereof, within and for said district, under and by virtue of the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas, including Chapter 2, Title 18, Revised Statutes 1911, as amended by Chapter 203, Acts of 1917, Regular Session, and Chapter 18, Acts Fourth Called Session of the Thirty-fifth Legislature, and the said district is hereby made and created a body corporate.

III. III.


It is further ordered by the Court that if the proposition to issue \$2,000.00 road bonds as prayed for in said petition does not receive a two-thirds majority of the vote cast at the election to be ordered by this Court for the purpose of determining whether or not said bonds shall be issued by said district, then this order shall become wholly null and void but if said proposition shall receive such necessary favorable vote, this order shall then remain in full force and effect while said bonds, or any of them, are outstanding obligations of said road district.
