

The Hon. Com. Court convened in Regular session on March the 12th 1923, with all Members presents.

The Court awarded the sale of Road Districts No 7- 8- 9- and 10 Bonds to H. C. Burt & Co. at the price of par and accrued interest.

It is ordered by the court that the County Treasurer pay to the Beaumont Building Material Company the amount of such monies for washed gravel and Washed sand, as shall be presented and marked O. K. by R. H. Minton and to pay off such freight bills for said Gravel and sand as shall be presented and marked O. K. by R. H. Minton and to Charge all such payments to the contract of R. H. Minton for construction of a portion of Highway No 21 in Sabine Co. Texas.

There being presented to the court a petition from the Citizens of Bronson, Texas on Aug. 1923 requesting that the court appoint J. L. Ludlow Justice Peace of Justice Precinct No 6, Sabine County, Texas, it is ordered by the court that J. L. Ludlow is hereby appointed Justice of the peace of Justice Precinct No 6, Sabine County, Texas, and the court hereby orders the County Clerk to issue to J. L. Ludlow a commission as Justice of said Justice Precinct.

It is ordered by the court that Jno Harper Co. Treasurer upon receipt of funds from sell of bonds of road district No 10, pay to J. W. Minton 1% of the ~~road~~ bonds as Atty's commissions in preparing field notes, etc. of said district.

It is ordered by the court that the county Treasurer transfer out of Gen Co. Fund funds to Gen Co. and Road and Bridge Funding Warrants funds to take care interest compounds that mature September 1st 1923.

It is ordered by the court that the County Treasurer make arrangements with the First National Bank of Hemphill, Texas, funds to take care of interest coupons due on Sept. 1st 1923, on bonds of Road district No. 10, and to have issued warrant against said road bond sinking fund bearing 5% interest from date of issuance until paid.

It is ordered by the court that J. H. Travis be allowed \$500.00 in part payment for assessing the taxes and making the tax rolls.
