

The Honorable Commissioner Court Met in Special Session, April 18th 1923.

Opened by Proclamation by the Sheriff. The following members present, W. H. Davidson, Co. Judge. J. H. Ener, County Clerk; E. W. Nations Sheriff, J. A. Ragan, Commissioner Precinct No. 1, J. M. Ball, Precinct No. 2, S. H. Hall, Commissioner Precinct No. 3. A. F. Vickers, Commissioner Precinct No. 4.

The following business was transacted: A motion by A. F. Vickers, Seconded by J. A. Ragan, and all court voted Aye. To advertise and let contract on the following road to-wit: The Court appointed a Jury of View which are five free holders in Sabine County. The Jury at View are as following R. S. Noble, L. H. Chandler, Sid Fuller, and Jim Partin, the Jury of View are to go upon the land of Sam Hankla, and assess the damage done to Mr. Hankley by the Highway going on said land.

IT IS ORDERED BY THE COURT that R. S. Noble, L. H. Chandler, J. S. Fuller, A. A. Barr, & Jim Partin five free holder of said County be and are hereby appointed a Jury of View, a majority of whom may, after taking the prescribed oath, before a properly authorized person, proceed to assess damages, on the premises of Sam Hankla, if any are claimed on, road beginning at San Augustine, County line, and terminating at Geneva, Known as Highway No. 21, and with W. A. French, the County Civil Engineer, to lay out and describe such road to the greatest advantage to the public, so that the same can be traced with certainty, and a description of the road together, with a statement of the damages assessed, if any, shall be included in the report of the jury, and, if adopted, shall be recorded in the Minutes of the Commissioners' Court. And it is further ordered, that the said Jury make a report in this cause at the next regular meeting of this court.
