

STATEMENT OF INDEBTEDNESS OF ROAD DISTRICT NO. 12, OF SABINE
COUNTY, TEXAS

This is a statement of indebtedness of Road District No. 12, of Sabine County, Texas.

The following is a complete statement of the indebtedness of Road District No. 12, of Sabine County, Texas, on the 29th day of June, 1923, the date of the bond order:

There are now outstanding \$421,00.00 forty year serial special road bonds of of Sabine County, bearing five and one-half per cent interest dated January 1st 1918.

There are now outstanding the following amount of warrant indebtedness against the entire county.

\$16,000.00 road and bridge warrants bearing six per cent interest dated February 15th 1921, payable \$2000.00 annually on March 1st.

\$6000.00 road and bridge warrants bearing six per cent interest dated December 1st 1915, payable \$2000.00 annually.

\$21,000.00 general county warrants bearing six per cent interest, dated February 15th 1921, payable \$2000.00 annually and \$3000.00 in 1923.

\$2000.00 road and bridge refunding warrants bearing six per cent interest, dated April 10th 1923, \$1000.00 payable 10th 1921, and \$1000.00 payable 10th 1932.

\$11,000.00 General County warrants bearing six per cent interest, dated March 15th 1923, \$5000.00 due March 15th 1929, and \$6000.00 due March 15th 1930.

There was no indebtedness of any kind existing against Road District No. 12, of Sabine County, Texas, on the 29th day of June, 1923, the date of the Bond Order.

The total value of the real property in Sabine County, Texas, as shown by the tax Rolls for 1922, is \$3,667,095.00.
