RESOLUTION PLACING COUNTY HIGHWAY FUNDS IN ESCROW.

Whereas, it is proposed to enter into a certain project agreement between the State Highway Department of Texas and the U. S. Secretary of Agriculture for the construction of that certain road described therein and known as Texas Federal Aid Project No 357 and State Aid Project No-390, located in Sabine County, Texas; and,

Whereas, the approved contract cost of Section A is \$44, 118.74 and the estimated cost of Section B is \$55909.94 making the total estimated cost of said Texas, Federal Project \$100028.68 of which a total of \$50014.34 State and Federal Aid has been set aside for this project; and

Whereas The U. S. Secretary of Agriculture requires that a satisfactory showing of funds be made before an agreement be entered into and

Whereas, The said project agreement provides that the Federal funds approved and set aside to the credit of said project shall be paid on monthly estimates as the construction work progresses, in accordance with the plans and specifications approved therefor; and that such partial payments shall at no time exceed the pro rata share of the Federal Government; and

Whereas, The U. S. Secretary of Agriculture has advised the State Highway Department of Texas that the said project agreement will not be entered into unless the completion

of said project in accordance with said plans and specifications can be assured and guaranteed by said county, making available, to be used exclusively for the purpose of completing said project, the sum of \$50014.34 which together with the Federal aid and State aid approved and set aside therefor it is estimated will provide sufficient funds for the completion of said project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Commissioners' Court of said Sabine County Texas, that the sum of \$50014.34 available from the funds of said County, is hereby appropriated and set aside, and will be placed in escrow in the First National Bank _____ the legally (or a specially) designated depository for said County, _____ (name of said Depository) State Aid project No. 390 worked performed in compleying the construction of said Texas Federal Aid Project No 357 and to be disbursed therefor by the said First National Bank only on vouchers submitted by said Commissioners Court when duly approved by the State Highway Engineer of Texas or his authorized agent; Provided, That any balance of said sum remaining upon the completion of said project and its final inspection and acceptance by the Secretary of Agriculture or his authorized representative shall be released from further obligation hereunder.
