COUNTY OF SABINE On this the 29th day of Sept. 1923 the County Commissioners Court convened in Special session at the regular meeting place thereof in the Courthouse at Hemphill Texas, all the members of said court to wit: W. H. Davidson Co. Judge; J. A. Ragin Commissioner Prec. No. 1; J. M. Ball Commissioner Prec. No. 2; S. H. Hall Commissioner Prec. No. 3; and A. F. Vickers Commissioners Prec. No. 4, being present and passed the following order and approvals;

(1) Ordered by the com. Court that the Co. Clk issue to J. H. Travis Tax Assessor a Gen. Co. Warrant in the sum of \$363.68 balance due assessor for assessing State & County Tax for year 1923.

(2) The Court ordered that \$1750 of the funds of Road District No 5 be spent on *The Yellow Pine*
and Brookeland ~~Hemphill and Jasper~~ road beginning at North line of Road District No. 8, extending a northeast-
erly direction and intersecting The Hemphill Yellowpine highway. The County Treasurer is or-
dered to set aside said amount to said road.

(3) On this day come on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 8th day of September 1923, in Common School District No 34 of this County upon the question of for or against increase of School Tax for said district and it appearing that said election was in all respects legally held and that said returns were duly and legally made and that there were cast at said election 6 votes of which number there were cast; For Increased of School Tax 6 votes Against Increase of School tax 0 votes and it appearing to the court from said returns that a majority of the qualified voters of said district voting at said election voted in favor of Increase in School tax therefore the Court does hereby declare that proposition for Increase to have been carried.

The Tax assessor presented for approval the state and county tax rolls for the year 1923 and same were checked and approved.
