

On the 27th day of Oct., 1923, the Commissioner's Court of Sabine County, Texas, convened in special Session all members thereof to wit:

W. H. Davidson, County Judge, J. A. Ragan, Commissioner Prec. No. 1 J. M. Ball Com. Prec. No. 2 S. H. Hall Commissioner Prec. No. 3 A. F. Vickers Commissioner Prec. No. 4 being present and among other proceedings had passed the following orders:

1. Appointing L. A. Jordan, J. V. Edgar, J. G. Low, C. W. Hammock and R. S. Noble as a Jury of Freeholders to lay out and assess damages to the property of all parties whomsoever claiming same resulting from establishing Highway Nos. 8 or 21 in Sabine County, Texas over which said Highway may run.

2. Awarding to Messrs. George and Kerr, Lufkin, Texas contract for constructing, grading, etc of 8.38 miles sec. A Highway No. 8 F. A. P. 327 A. Sabine County, Texas upon their making bond acceptable to the Federal and State Highway departments.

3. Awarding to E. M. Wood, Royse City, Texas, contract for constructing graveling, etc of 7.19 miles Sec. B Highway No 21 F. A. P. 357 A Sabine County, Texas, upon his making bond acceptable to the Federal and State Highway departments.

The Court appointed W. C. Shumaker, J. V. Edgar, J. G. Low, C. W. Hammock and R. S. Noble as a Jury of Freeholders to lay out and assess damages to the property of all parties whomsoever claiming same resulting from establishing Highway No. 8 in Sabine County Texas.

Appointing Minton & Lewis, Attorneys at law of Hemphill Texas to collect by suit or otherwise all delinquent Taxes of every kind and character as they now appear upon the delinquent tax Records and Delinquent Tax report of Sabine County Texas, with penalties and interest
