A. F. Vickers Commissioner Precinct No. 4; court was opened by proclamation by the Sheriff the following were had to wit:

It is ordered by the Commissioners Court that R. H. Minton is this day employed to assist the County Attorney in the collection of all delinquent taxes of every kind and character as they now appear upon the Delinquent Tax Records of Sabine County, Texas; and that the said R. H. Minton is to pay such expenses as may be incurred in the preparation of abstracts and getting up other data as may be necessary and incident to the filing of suits for the collection of such taxes.

It is further ordered that the Tax Collector of Sabine county Texas, is hereby authorized and directed to pay to the said R. H. Minton at the end of each month out of the Delinquent Taxes so collected, a sum not to exceed twenty five per cent (25%) of all county taxes so collected by suit or toherwise which sum shall be full compensation for all services rendered by the said R. H. Minton in the collection of such taxes.
