That the First National Bank of Hemphill, Texas, take up all bonds and coupons that mature January 1st, 1924; that the County Treasurer cannot take up and hold until the County has funds to reimburse the bank, for which the bank will be allowed 5% interest.

That the act appointing _____ to assist the County Attorney in the collection of delinquent taxes be rescinded.

That George & Kerr of Mount Pleasant, Texas, being the lowest bidders be awarded the Contract for Section B, Highway No. 8, Sabine County, Texas, conditioned that they make bond satisfactory to the Federal & Statute Highway Department and to the Commissioners Court.
