

County Judge's Order for Stock Law Election.

THE STATE OF TEXAS.

COUNTY OF SABINE.

WHEREAS, on the 11th day of February, A.D. 1924, a petition was presented to the commissioners court of Sabine county, Texas, at its regular session, asking that an election be ordered in and for the following subdivision of Sabine county, Texas, to determine whether or not hogs, sheep or goats, shall be allowed to run at large within said territory, to-wit: Beginning in Sabine county, Texas, at the most easterly corner of the M.D. White survey on the N. Bank of Polo Goch creek same being one of the corners of the Moses Hill League. Thence W. 810 vrs. to the S.W. corner of said Moses Hill League. Thence N. with the W. line of said Moses Hill League to its N.W. corner.

Thence E with the N-line of said Moses Hill League about 2587 vrs. to the most northerly N.E. corner of the said Moses Hill League. Thence S. 65 $\frac{1}{2}$ E with the N.E. line of the said Moses Hill League 500 vrs. to the S.E. corner of the Major Smith Survey. Thence N. with the E-line of said Major Smith Survey, 917 vrs. to its N.E. corner.
