

The Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, in regular Session on February 12th, 1924, all members of the court present accepted and approved of the report of the Jury of Freeholders Composed of R.S. Noble, J.G. Low, W.C. Shumaker, C.W. Hammock and J.V. Edgar, who were appointed by the court in Special Session February 2nd, 1924, to survey and assess damages resulting from highway No. 8, in Sabine County, Texas, passing through No. 8, the property of the following named persons and ordered that the amount opposite their names be paid them as damages: Lewis Letney \$100.00, L.L. Bradshaw \$25.00, Ben Hamilton \$265.00, Print Bell \$200.00, Calvin McClelland \$125.00, W.W. Defee \$25.00, Miss Claudie Spence \$250.00, Emmett Carodin \$30.00, R.O. Murray \$30.00, Ernest Cooper \$25.00.

The County Clerk is hereby ordered by the court to issue warrants against Road Bond District No. 10, in favor of the parties herein named and in the amount of damages allowed each party named and that the County Treasurer deposit in the County Treasury said amounts to the credit of said parties and notify them of same.

Ordered by the Commissioners Court that W.A. French, County Engineer, estimate the cost of constructing and graveling certain streets in the town of Hemphill, and the Pineland Highway from Hemphill to Pineland, ordered by the Court that R.S. Noble be allowed \$60.00 for his services as Jury of review on Highway No. 8, and \$3.00 for use of his car for services rendered February 11, and 12, 1924, That W.C. Sumaker, J.V. Edgar, C.W. Hammock, be allowed \$6.00 each for their services as Jury of review on Highway No. 8, February 11 and 12th, 1924, and that J.G. Low be allowed \$3.00 as services as Jury of review on Highway No. 8, on Feb. 11th, 1924. That A.J. Neal be allowed \$10.00 for his service transferring Jury of review to Pineland on February 12th, 1924.
