

ELECTION ORDER.

THE STATE OF TEXAS,

COUNTY OF SABINE.

On this the 10th day of March 1924, the commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, convened in session, at the regular meeting

place thereof in the courthouse at Hemphill, Texas, all members of the court, to-wit:

sidered the petition of E.R. Smith, and 43 others persons, praying that bonds be issued by Road District No. 12, of Sabine County, Texas, in the sum of \$15000 bearing 5% rate of interest maturing at such times as may be fixed by the commissioners court, serially or otherwise, not to exceed thirty years from date thereof, for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating macadamized, graded or paved roads and turnpikes, or in aid thereof, and whether or not a tax shall be levied upon the property of said Road District No. 12, of Sabine county, Texas, subject to taxation for the purpose of paying the interest on said bonds to provide a sinking fund for the redemption thereof at maturity, and it appearing to the court that said petition is signed by more than majority of the resident property taxpaying voters of said Road District No. 12, of Sabine county, Texas; and it further appearing that the amount of bonds to be issued will not exceed one fourth, of the assessed valuation of the real property of said County, Texas, and it further appearing that said Road District No. 12, of Sabine county, Texas, has been duly established by an order of the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, dated the 10th day of March 1924, of record in Book M, pages 179, of the

held under the provisions of Articles 627, to 641, inclusive, of Chapter 2, Title 18, Revised Statutes, 1911, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 203, Acts of 1917, Regular Session. All persons who are legally qualified voters of this State and of this County, and who are resident property taxpayers, in this Road District No. 12, of Sabine County, Texas, shall be entitled to vote at said election, and all voters desiring to support the proposition to issue the bonds shall have written or printed on their ballots the words: "For the issuance of bonds and the levying of the tax in payment thereof". and those opposed shall have written or printed on their ballots the words: "Against the issuance of bonds and the levying of the tax in payment thereof". The polling places and presiding officers of said election shall be respectively as follows: At Gomer School House, with T.W. Low, as Presiding Officer. The manner of holding said election shall be governed by the general laws of the State of Texas, regulating general elections, when not in conflict with the provisions of the Statutes hereinabove referred to. Notice of said election shall be given by publication of a copy of this order in the Sabine County Reporter a newspaper published in Sabine County, Texas, for four successive weeks before the date of said election and, in addition thereto, there shall be posted other copies of this order at three public places in the Road District No. 12, of Sabine County, Texas, for three weeks prior to said election.

The County Judge is hereby directed to cause said notices to be published and posted, as hereinabove directed, and further orders are reserved until the returns of said election are made by the duly authorized election officers and received by this court.
