On motion of J. A. Ragan Sec. by S. H. Hall, and all the Court voted to

The Court after reading the desires of the Magnolia Gas Co. passed the
following order:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, that MAGNOLIA GAS COMPANY, a corporation, its successors and assigns, is hereby granted the right to construct, operate and maintain a pipe-line or pipe lines for the transportation of gas or oil, or any of its or their products, over and along any and all the public roads of Sabine County, Texas, also the right to erect and maintain along and upon the said roads a line of poles with telephone and telegraph wires thereon. The said lines are to be so constructed as not to interfere with public travel in any way or to damage the public highway. It is distinctly understood and agreed that the said Magnolia Gas Company, its successors and assigns, in the construction and maintenance of the aforesaid lines shall at all times be subject to and conform to the orders of the Commissioners Court and the County Engineer of Sabine County, Texas.

We, the undersigned officers, holding an election on the 10 day of May 1924, in Common School District No. 3 of said County for the purpose of determining whether or not the Commissioner's Court of said County shall be authorized to levy, assess and collect annually a tax of, and at the rate of, 75 cts. on the one hundred dollars valuation of taxable property in said District for the purpose of supplementing the State School Fund apportioned to said District, hereby certify that at said election there were cast 28 votes, of which number, there were cast,

For Increase of tax 17 votes.

Against increase tax 11 votes.

Majority for the tax 6 votes.

On this May 12th, 1924 came on to be considered the returns of an election held on May 10th 1924, in Common School District No. 3, of this County upon the question of determining whether or not a tax of and at the rate of 75 cents on the \$100 valuation of taxable property in said District shall be levied for the purpose of supplementing the State School Fund apportioned to said district, and it appearing that said election was in all respects legally held and that said returns were duly and legally made, and that there were cast at said election 28 votes, of which number, there were cast:

For the Increase of School Tax 17 votes.

Against the Increase of School Tax 11 votes.

And it appearing to the Court from said returns that a majority of the qualified property taxpaying voters of said district voting at said election, voting in favor of increasing the School Tax, and that this Court is authorized to levy and have assess and collect annually said tax.

Ordered by the Court that the County Clerk issue Scrip against Road Bond Sinking Fund Road Dist., #12 in favor of the following named parties and in the amounts apposite their names as a tax refund.

To the Honorable Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, We, the undersigned, being resident citizens within the hereinafter described territory situated in Sabine County, Texas, respectfully represent:

First: That we are resident property taxpaying voters within said territory.

Second: That we desire your Honorable body to order an election to determine whether or not the bonds of said territory, to be known and designated as "Road District No. 12, of Sabine County, Texas," shall be issued in the amount of FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS, bearing five and one-half per cent rate of interest and maturing at such times as may be fixed by the Commissioners' Court, serially or otherwise, not to exceed thirty years from date thereof, for the purpose of constructing and operating macadamized, graveled or paved roads and turnpikes or in aid thereof; and whether or not a tax shall be levied upon the property of said proposed Road District subject to taxation, for the purpose of paying the interest on said bonds and to provide a sinking fund for the redemption thereof at maturity.

Third: That the territory which we pray your Honorable body to designate as Road District No. 12, of Sabine County, Texas, is accurately described by metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning in Sabine County, Texas, at a point on the West bank of the Sabine River, at the mouth of the Pologoch Creek.

Thence in a Westerly direction up the Pologoch Creek to the West line of the Shadrack Morris Survey.

Thence in a Southwesterly direction with the West line of the Shadrack Morris survey to the most southerly corner of the J. A. Hines Survey.

Thence South with the West line of the Shadrack Morris to its Southwest corner on the E. line of the J. S. Lacy League.

Thence South with the E. line of the J. S. Lacy League and the West line of the Issac Low Survey to the N. E. Corner of a 60 acre tract known as the Walker tract on the John S. Lacy League now owned by A. D. Hamilton and others.

Thence West with the North line of the Walker 50 acres and another 50 acre tract owned by A. D. Hamilton and others, and the North line of a 100 acre subdivision of the John S. Lacy owned by A. D. Hamilton and others to the East line of the Moosa Jackson 80 acre sub-division of the J. S. Lacy League.

Thence South with the East line of the Moosa Jackson 80 acres and the west line of the A. D. Hamilton, et al, 100 acres, to the South boundary line of the J. S. Lacy League.

Thence East with the South boundary line of the J. S. Lacy League to the N. W. corner of the Martha Bullock 220 acre survey.

Thence south with the West line of the Martha Bullock Survey to its S. W. corner.

Thence East with the South line of the Martha Bullock Survey to the West boundary line of T & N. O. R. R. Co., Section No. 4.

Thence S. with the west boundary line of T & N. O. R. R. Co., Section No. 4, to its S. W. corner.

Thence E. with the S. B. line of T & N. O. R. R. Co., Section 4, to its S. E. corner on the W. B. line of the H. E. & W. T. R. R. Co., Section No. 7.

Thence N. with the W. B. line of H. E. & W. T. R. R. Co., Section No. 7, to its N. W. corner on the E. line of T & N. O. Section No. 4.

Thence E. with the North line of H. E. & W. T. R. R. Co., Section No. 7, to the N. W. corner of H. E. & W. T. R. R. Co., Section No. 8.

Thence S. with the West boundary line of H. E. & W. T. R. R. Co., Section No. 8 to its Southwest corner.

Thence E. with the South line of H. E. & W. T. R. R. Co., Section No. 8, to its S. E. corner on the W. B. line of the D. Blackman Survey.

Thence S. with the W. B. line of the D. Blackman Survey to its S. W. corner same being the S. E. corner of T. & N. O. R. R. Co., Survey No. 8, Abstract No. 469.

Thence West with the S. B. line of said T. & N. O. R. R. Co., Survey No. 8, Abstract 469, to the N. E. corner of the Benjamin Slaughter Survey.

Thence South with the E. line of the Benjamin Slaughter Survey to its S. E. corner.

Thence Westerly with the S. line of the Benjamin Slaughter Survey to the N. E. corner of the William Parmer Survey.

Thence South with the E. line of the William Parmer to its S. E. corner on the N. line of the G. L. Bourland League.

Thence N. 69 E. with the N. line of the G. L. Bourland League to the west bank of Sabine River.

Thence up the Sabine River with its meanders to the place of beginning.

Fourth: That the above described territory is situated wholly within Sabine County, Texas, and does not over-lap or embrace any part of a political sub-division or defined "road District that has heretofore been established and issued road bonds which are now outstanding and unpaid.

Fifth: That the proceeds of the issuance of said bonds shall be used for the purpose of building a road beginning at the East line of the Moosa Jackson 80 acre sub-division on the J. S. Lacy League.

Thence Eastwardly by way of John Harper's, Wade Anderson's, V. B. Youngblood's and Josh Gomer's residences.

Thence Northwardly with the old Burkeville and Sabinetown road through Sabinetown to the bridge on the Pologoch Creek near the mouth of said Creek.
