Ordered that the County Clerk issue Gen. County scrip to Rev. T. H. Windham in the sum of \$423.28 in payment of the Soldiers monument purchased of him and that the clerk issue to T. J. Burnes Gen. scrip in the sum of \$30.00 for the constitution of the cement foundation of the Memorial and the erection of the monument and that the county Treasurer have same cashed. The Official Bond of E. W. Nations Sheriff was presented and approved by a unanimous vote of the court.

Ordered by the Court that the County Clerk issue Gen. scrip in favor of Mrs. Mattie Wilderson in the sum of \$25.00 to bear her expenses to the Rusk Sanitarium.
