The following together with other were had to wit:

On this 12th day of July, A. D. 1924, came on to be considered the returns of an election held in Common School Districts Nos. 17 & 35 on June 14th A. D. 1924 In Common School Districts Nos. 15 & 26 on June 28th, A. D. 1924- In Common School District No. 27 on July 5th, A. D. 1924- In Common School District Nos. 8 & 36 on July 12th A. D. 1924. For the purpose of determining whether or not the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas shall be authorized to levy, assess, and collect annually a tax of and at the rate of 75 cents on the One hundred dollars valuation of the taxable property in said districts for the purpose of supplementing the State School fund, apportioned to said districts, and it is found that there were cast in said election in District No. 17, 34 votes; 20 of which number were cast "For School Tax" and 14 of which were cast "Against School Tax". Majority for the tax 6 votes. In District No. 35, there were cast 15 votes; 9 of which number were cast "For School Tax" and 4 of which were cast "Against School Tax". Majority for the

tax 5 votes. In District No. 15, there were cast 7 votes; All seven of which were cast "For the Tax". In District No. 26, there were cast 13 votes; 12 of which number were cast for School Tax" and 1 of which was cast "Against School Tax". Majority for the tax 11 votes.

In District No. 27, there were cast 24 votes; 12 of which number were cast "For School Tax" and 11 of which were cast "Against School Tax". Majority for the tax 2 votes.

In District No. 36, there were cast 21 votes; all 21 of which were cast for School Tax".

In District No. 8, there were cast 16 votes; 11 of which were cast for School Tax", and 5 of which were cast against School Tax". Majority for the Tax 6 votes.
