COUNTY OF SABINE | On this the 18 day of October 1924, the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County, Texas, being in regular session, at a regular term of said Court, all members thereof being present, the following proceedings, among others, were had, to-wit:

WHEREAS, heretofore, to-wit, on the 15th day of March, 1923, the Commissioners' Court of Sabine County passed an order authorizing the issuance of \$35,000 Funding Warrants for the purpose of funding \$35,000 outstanding scrip or warrants against the General Fund of said County, and for the further purpose of funding warrants issued in payment of valid indebtedness incurred in the construction of improvements, purchase of materials,

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and other expenses incurred under the provisions of the laws of the State of Texas, and the Acts of the Legislature referred to in said order; which order is recorded in Book "M", pages 21 et seq., of the Minutes of said Court; and

WHEREAS, in pursuance of said order, certain scrip or warrants have been issued against the General Fund of Sabine County, in payment of claims which were duly audited and allowed by the Commissioners' Court of said County prior to the issuance of said warrants, and which are valid, subsisting and binding obligations against Sabine County, said warrants being as follows:

BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF SABINE COUNTY TEXAS, that said original warrants against the General Fund of Sabine County, herein listed, be and the same are hereby in all things validated and held and declared to be valid, existing, binding and unsatisfied obligations against Sabine County, and the acts of the court officers in the issuance of said warrants are hereby in all things validated and confirmed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, in conformity with said warrant order, passed on the 27th day of March, 1923, SABINE COUNTY FUNDING WARRANTS in the amount of \$8,000.00 a stated course (100) from thirty (30) to thirty five (35) inclusive, in the denomination of \$1000 each, of an issue of thirty-five (35) warrants, aggregating \$35,000, dated March 25, 1923, bearing interest at the rate of six per centum per annum, be executed and delivered to the Security Trust Company, the owner and holder of the said original warrants herein listed, upon surrender and cancellation of said original warrants.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that W. H. Davidson, Court Judge of Sabine County, Texas, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to deliver said warrants numbers 30 to 35 inclusive to the Security Trust Company, and the original warrants herein listed to be cancelled and to be and cancelled; said Funding Warrants to be delivered to the order and to the satisfaction of said original warrants.

The Honorable Commissioners' Court convened in regular session on this the 10th day of Nov. 1924 with all members thereof present.

The Following together with other were had to wit:

The Officers were allowed their salary for the month of Oct. 1924.

Ordered by the Court to pay all officers holding Gen. Election on Nov. 4th.

A petition was presented to the court signed by M. S. Morris & nine others persons asking for a change in the Milam & Sabinetown public road, as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the May haw pond on said road and leading in westerly or northwesterly direction to intersect highway No. 21, in said county.

It is hereby ordered by the Commissioners' Court to allow said change and the Court will allow one hundred dollars for the opening up of said new road.

Ordered by the court to allow Mrs. Mollie Lakey, \$10.00 as County aid.

A Petition was presented to the Commissioners' Court signed by M. Humphrey & nine others persons asking for a change in the Hemphill & San Augustine Public road to-wit:

Beginning between Albert White's and Will Roberts running an easterly direction to the Mott and Warren line. Thence with or about said line to where said line crosses the Hemphill & San Augustine Public road east of the Woodman Hall.

Ordered by the Court to allow said change in said road.

A petition signed by J. J. McGown & 14 other persons asking for the Court to make the following change in the public road leading from Gravel Hill church to J. J. McGown's residence to-wit:

Turn South at Clarence Conn's residence and intersect the Highway at Curtis Carlton's residence in stead of at the 5 mile board.

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permitted to run at large therein, and desiring that said classes of animals shall not run at large therein, hereby petition said court to designate the following described territory within such county as a subdivision wherein and wherefor such election may be ordered and held, to-wit:

Beginning in Sabine County, Texas, at the southwest corner of the John Smith league of land on the eastern boundary of Geneva Stock Law Subdivision.

Thence south 70 degrees east with the south line of said John Smith league to its corner 94 varas south 70 degrees east from the north east corner of the Ira McDaniel survey.

Thence South 31 degrees east 671 varas to the corner of the J. O. Toole tract of land on the Isaac Carradine Survey.

Thence South $\frac{1}{2}$ degrees east with the west line of said Toole tract 1292 varas to its southwest corner.

Thence east with the south line of said Toole tract 589 varas to the northeast corner of the Hewett and Dowdy tract same being northwest corner 40 acres for the White heirs.

Thence south $7\frac{1}{2}$ degrees east with the east line of the Hewett & Dowdy tract and the R. J. Sheights tract, at 1253 varas reached the northwest line of the Matthew Parker survey.
