

COUNTY JUDGE'S ORDER FOR STOCK LAW ELECTION

STATE OF TEXAS

COUNTY OF SABINE WHEREAS, on the 10th day of November, A.D. 1924, a petition was presented to the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas at its regular session asking that an election be ordered in and for the following subdivision of Sabine County, Texas to determine whether or not hogs, sheep or goats shall be allowed to run at large within said territory, to-wit:

Beginning in Sabine County, Texas at the S.W. corner of the John Smith league of land on the eastern boundary of Geneva Stock Law Subdivision.

Thence south 70 degrees E. with the S. line of said John Smith league to its corner 94 yrs. S. 70 deg. E. from the N.E. corner of the Ira McDaniel survey; thence S. 31 deg. E. 671 yrs. to the corner of the J. Q. Toole tract of land on the Isaac Carradine survey; thence S. 1-2 deg. E. with the W. line of said Toole tract 1292 yrs. to its S.W. corner; thence E. with the S. line of said Toole tract 689 yards to the N.E. cor. of the Hewett and Dowdy tract, same being N.W. cor. 40 acres for the White heirs; thence S. 7 1-4 deg. E. and with the E. line of the Hewett/Dowdy tract and the R. J. Speights tract at 1253 yrs. reached the N.W. line of the Mathew, Parker survey; thence S. 49 1-2 degs. W. with said Parker's line to Pologoch creek; thence down said Pologoch creek with its meanders to the cor. of the Moses Hill league; thence with one of the S. line of said Hill League about 810 yrs. to the S.W. cor. of Hill League; thence N. with the W. line of said Hill League to the S.

corner of the J.T. Davidson survey; (the largest Davidson survey); thence W. with the S. line of said Davidson survey to its S.W. corner on the E. line of the B.D. Latham survey; thence N. 14 deg. W. with the W. line of said Davidson survey to its N.W. cor. on the S. line of the Isaac Carradine survey; thence N. 49 1-2 deg. E. with said Carradine line and the Davidson line to the S.W. cor. of the 100 acres in the name of Mrs. L.E. Goodrich, on said Carradine survey; thence northwesterly with the W. boundary line of said Goodrich 100 acres to its N.W. cor. on the N. line of said Carradine survey and S. line of the Jeff Wilson survey; thence N. 88 deg. E. with S. line said Wilson and N. line said Carradine surveys to the S.W. corner of the land owned by A. N. Wooley and S. E. corner of land owned by Miss Maggie Pace; thence northerly with road making the line between Miss Pace and Mr. Wooley to the N. line of the said Wilson survey and the N.W. cor. of the Wooley land and N.E. cor. of said Miss Pace tract of land, this corner being at or near the E.W. cor. of the S. H. Oliphint preemption; thence E. or W. as the case may be if this last above described corner is not with the S.W. cor. of said Oliphint survey, to the S.W. cor. of said S. H. Oliphint survey; thence N. with the W. line of said Oliphint survey and the E. line of the Isaac Powell and W. line of the John S. Chivaler survey to the S.E. cor. of the Jefferson Wilson subdivision of 1107 acres of Isaac Powell league; thence W. with the S. line of said Jefferson Wilson 1107 acres to its S.W. cor. on the eastern line of the John Smith league thence N. 84 deg. W. with the eastern line of said John Smith league to its N.E. corner; thence W. with the N. line of said John Smith league to the eastern boundaries of the Geneva Stock Law Subdivision thence southerly with the eastern boundaries of said Geneva Stock Law Subdivision to the place of beginning.

And whereas, on said 10th day of November, 1924, said petition was granted by said Commissioners Court in regular session assembled, and said election as prayed for in said petition was granted by said Court said petition being signed by the required number of free holders and being in conformity with law, now, therefore, I, W. H. Davidson County Judge of Sabine County, Texas, in my capacity as such, and in conformity with said order that an election be held within and for said above described subdivision of Sabine County Texas, to determine whether or not hogs, sheep or goats shall be allowed to run at large within the above described subdivision of said County, said election to be held on the 22nd day of December, A.D. 1924, in the Ped Davidson Old Store building in Milan, Texas, within said subdivision of Sabine County, Texas and I hereby appoint A.B. Russell presiding Judge of said election and W. M. Davidson and Pole Mason as managers of said election.

All legally qualified voters who are free holders residing within said subdivision are entitled to vote in said election.

The election shall be held and conducted and the returns thereof made in accordance with the laws regulating general elections.

I hereby further order that notice of said election be published for five successive weeks in the Sabine County Reporter, a weekly newspaper published in Sabine County, Texas.

The polls at said election shall be opened at 8 o'clock A.M. and shall not close before 7 o'clock P.M.

Herein fail not to make due and proper returns of the election to the County Judge of Said County within ten days from the day of election.
