

On this the 15th day of Nov. 1924 the Hon. Commissioners' Court convened in special session. All Officers present.

S. H. Hall County Commissioner of pre. #3

presented his resignation as commissioner of Pre. #3. The same was accepted.

After accepting the resignation of Sheriff E.W. Nations the County Judge gave order of the the vacancy of the Sheriff office, the Court appointed S. H. Hall to fill out the unexpired term of E. W. Nations as Sheriff of Sabine County, Texas.

Ordered by the Co. Judge that the office of Comm. Pre. #3 in vacant and it is hereby

ordered by the County Judge that J. T. Foley be and is hereby appointed to fill out the unexpired term of S. H. Hall.

Ordered by the Court that the Sheriff rid the public square of all live stock and keep same off of said public square.

Ordered by the Court that J. E. Emer County Clerk issue against the permanent improvement Fund in favor of J. T. McCown in the sum of \$3000.00 in payment the following viz:

1st. A right-of-way sixty feet in width for a public highway from the west side of that certain 175 acres of the Jas. Gains League purchased by J. T. McCown from J. W. Clifton to the west bank of the Sabine River to be used for the purpose of erecting and maintaining a public highway as now surveyed.

2nd. The Ferry Boat and all ropes and appliances now used in maintaining the Ferry at Sabine River also one skiff used in connection therewith.

3rd. The perpetual right to maintain a Ferry on the Highway leading from Milan to the town of Many, across Sabine river.
