Motion made by A. F. Vickers seconded by S. H. Hall to raise the County Clerk's salary from the average of \$58.35 per month or \$700.00 per to \$75.00 per month or \$900.00 per year. A. F. Vickers, S. H. Hall and J. M. Ball voted Y, and J. A. Ragan voted no.

Motion made by A. F. Vickers Seconded by S. H. Hall to raise the District Clerk's salary from \$700.00 per year to \$780.00 per year. A. F. Vickers, S. H. Hall and J. M. Ball voted Y, J. A. Ragan voted No.

The resignation of S. H. Hall was on this day presented his resignation to the court and same was to take effect at once. The Court accepted the resignation of S. H. Hall.
