being present, and among other proceedings came on to be considered the returns of an election held on 22nd day of Dec. 1924, in the Ped. Davidson old store building in Milan, Sabine County, Texas, to determine whether or not hogs, sheep or goats shall be allowed to run at large within the described subdivision of said County as set out in the County Judge's order of election of the date of 18th day of Nov. A.D. 1924, and it appearing that said election was in all respects legally held and that said returns were duly and legally made and that there were cast at said election 24 votes, of which number there were cast:

For stock law 22 votes

Against the stock law 2 votes

and it appearing to the Court from said returns that a majority of the qualified voters the same being freeholders of said subdivision voting at said election, voting in favor of the Stock law, the Court does hereby declare the proposition for the stock law to have been adopted.

Therefore, I, W. H. Davidson, County Judge, Sabine County, Texas, by the authority vested in me under Art. 7221, Revised Civil Statutes, 1920, hereby declare the result of the election as in favor of the Stock Law. Dated this January 5th, 1925.
