The following were had to wit:- (1) On the account of the Neptis Law Dr. C. F. Smith turned in his resignation as Co. health officer, and the Court appointed Dr. J. H. Mattox as County Health officer.

(2) County Judge ordered by Court to issue notice for County depository.

(3) The Court reissued Burr & Burr of Bronson, the sum of \$51.56 and excess of 1924 Taxes.

(4) Moved by C. W. Fuller second by J. T. Foley, for the County Officers to furnish their own wood. The Court voted aye.

(5) Motion by C. W. Fuller, second by W. J. McDaniel to allow the Jailer 75 cents per day for feeding prisoners, where the prisoners don't exceed five prisoners, and after the prisoners exceed 5 then the fee is to return back to 60 cents per day.

(6) Ordered by the Court to allow the County Judge, \$1400.00, County Clerk \$900.00 and Sheriff \$1000.00. Motion by R. C. Travis to raise the Co. Attorney's Salary to \$600.00 per year., second by C. W. Fuller. R. C. Travis & C. W. Fuller vote aye, W. J. McDaniel and J. T. Foley voted, no., the/being tied Judge W. H. Davidson voted aye.

District Clark's Salary-----Moved by W. J. McDaniel, second by J. T. Foley, for his salary to remain as at \$700.00, W. J. McDaniel, J. T. Foley and R. C. Travis, votes aye.

Ordered by the Court that the County Treasurer's fee remain as past year.

A Motion by R. C. Travis to allow the amount of \$5.00 per month for a night watchmen for the town of Hemphill. Second by J. T. Foley, for six months, the Court voted aye.

COUNTY OF SABINE | To the Honorable Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas:

We, the undersigned, being resident citizens within the hereinafter described territory situated in Sabine County, Texas, respectfully represent:

First: That we are resident property tax paying voters within said territory.

Second: That we desire your honorable body to order an election to determine whether or not the bonds of said territory, to be known and designated as "Road District No. 13, of Sabine County, Texas," shall be issued in the amount of \$9000.00, bearing five and one-half (5½) per cent rate of interest, and maturing at such times as may be fixed by the

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Commissioners Court, serially or otherwise, not to exceed thirty years from date, thereof, for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating macadamized, graveled or paved roads and turnpikes, or in aid thereof; and whether or not a tax shall be levied upon the property of said proposed road district, subject to taxation, for the purpose of paying the interest on said bond and to provide a sinking fund for the redemption of thereof at maturity.

The proceeds of said bonds to be used and spent upon the following portions of the public roads in said District:

On the road known as the Hemphill and Pineland road beginning at the Southwest boundary line of the town of East Mayfield and continuing in a Southwesterly direction with said road leading from Hemphill to Pineland to the point where said road crosses the East Boundary line of road District No. 10, of Sabine County, Texas, near the present residence of J. H. Travis,

Third: That the territory which we pray your honorable body to designate as "Road District No. 13, of Sabine County, Texas, is accurately described by metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning in said Sabine County, Texas, at the most southerly corner of the Collins Buckley Survey in the W. boundary line of the Joseph Walker Headright.

Thence N. 58 W. with Buckley's S.B. line to the N.W. cor. of the M.E. Griffin 58 acre survey.

Thence S. 32 W. with Griffin's W.B. line and M.J. Brumley's E.B. line to M.J. Brumley's S.E. cor. in N. B. line of H. S. White Survey.

Thence S. 58 E. with H. S. White's N.B. line to his N. E. corner.

Thence S. 32 W. with White's E.B. line and M.E. Griffin W.B. line to H. S. White's S.E. cor. in N. B. line of R. H. Smith's Headright.

Thence in a S.W. direction to the N.E. corner of a survey of 120 acres owned by W.R. Davidson.

Thence N. 75 W. with Davidson's N. B. line to the N.W. corner of said 120 acres.

Thence S. 5 E. about 189 yrs. to the N. B. line of 100 acres owned by W. R. Davidson.

Thence S. 83-2/4 W. with Davidson's N. B. line to the W.B. line of R.H. Smith Headright.

Thence with Smith's W.B. line and Clark's E. B. line to Housen Bayou.

Thence westerly up Housen Bayou to the mouth of Watts creek.

Thence up Watts Creek to the W. B. line of a 200 acre survey owned by Huffman.

Thence N. 6 W. to the N.E. corner of the J. A. Travis 100 acre survey.

Thence W. 1034 yrs. to the N.W. cor. of J. A. Travis 100 acres on the E. B. line of 500 acres owned by Chapman and Gallup.

Thence S. 6 E. with said E. B. line of 500 acres to the N.W. corner of 90 acres owned by Temple Lumber Company.

Thence N. 85 1/2 E. 614 yrs. to the N. W. cor. of 9 acres owned by J. H. Travis.

Thence S. 5 E. 410 yrs. to the S.W. cor. of said 9 acres.

Thence N. 85 1/2 E. 124 yrs. to the S.E. corner of 9 acres in the E.B. line John Clark, and the W.B. line of the Isaac P. Pace Survey.

Thence South with the W.B. line of the Isaac P. Pace to the S.W. Corner of the I. W. Tatom 197 acre tract.

Thence East with the South line of the I. W. Tatom 197 acres to its S.E. corner.

Thence North with the East line of said I. W. Tatom's 197 acres to its N.E. corner.

Thence West with the North line of said Tatom 197 acres to its N.W. corner on the W. line of the Isaac Pace Survey, same being the S.W. corner of Mrs. Ada Conner's 54 acre tract.

Thence North with the West line of Mrs. Ada Conner's 54 acres to her N.W. corner.

Thence East with Mrs. Conner's North line and the South line of W.F. Goodrich 90 acre tract to the old Hemphill and Jasper road.

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Thence in a northeasterly direction with said old Hemphill and Jasper road to the north line of the Isaac F. Pace Survey.

Thence S. 72-3/4 East with I.F. Pace North boundary line to its N. E. corner on the West boundary line of the Sion Smith League.

Thence South 32 West with the Sion Smith West boundary line, which is the west boundary line of W.F. Goodriches land to the S.W. corner of said Goodrich tract on the W.B. line of the Sion Smith League.

Thence in an Easterly direction with the South line of W.F. Goodrich's land to the S. W. corner of the Drew Easley or Carroll tract of land.

Thence in an Easterly direction with the South line of the Drew Easley or Carroll tract to its S.E. corner which is also the S.W. corner of R.K. Beckcom's tract.

Thence with Beckcom's South boundary line in an Easterly direction to the S.E. corner of said R. K. Beckcom's tract of land.

Thence N. 30 E. with R. K. Beckcom's E. B. line to his corner on the S. bank of Housen Bayou.

Thence down Housen Bayou to where the West boundary line of the right-of-way of the old Hemphill and Jasper road crosses said Creek.

Thence in an Northerly direction with the W. boundary line of said Hemphill and Jasper road to Cooper branch.

Thence up Cooper Branch with its meanders to the Southeast corner of the town of East Mayfield.

Thence S. 75 W. with the S. line of the town of East Mayfield to its S. W. corner.

Thence N. 15 W. with the West line of the town of East Mayfield to its N.W. corner.

Thence N. 75 E. with the N. line of the town of East Mayfield to the W. B. line of the Joseph Walker survey.

Thence N. 15 W. with the W. B. line of the Joseph Walker Survey to the most Southerly corner of the Collins Buckley Survey, the place of beginning.

Fourth: That the above described territory is situated wholly within Sabine County, Texas, and does not over-lap or embrace any part of a political sub-division or defined Road District that has heretofore been established and issued Road Bonds which are now outstanding and unpaid.
