COUNTY OF SABINE On this the $21 s t$ day of Januery, A.D. 1925, the County Commissi oners Court convened in regular session at the regular meetingsplace thereof in the courthouse at Hemphill, Texas, all the members of said Court to-wit:

R.C.Travis, Commissi oner of Preainot No. 4, being present, and passed the following order:

WHEREAS, a petition signed by'J.|H. Travia and twenty seven other persons, has this day
been wresented to this court praying that bonds be issued in the sum of Nine Thousand. (\$9000. 00 ) Dollars for the purpose of construating, maintaining and operating macadamized, graveled or paved roads and turnpikes, or in aid thereof, within the territory therein defined and which said petitioners pray this Court to oreate as a road district, to be known and designated as "Road District No. 13, of Sabine County, 'Pexas," and,

IT APPEARING to the Court that said petition bears the requisite number of singatres of resident property tax paying voters within the propoped road district; and,

IT FURTHER APPEARING to the Court that it is desirable to eatablish said road district; and,

IT FURTHER APPEARING to the Court that the boundaries* of said proposed dis.tric"t as described and defined in said petition do not over-lap or embrace any part of a political subdivision or defined road district that has heretofore been established and issued road bonds whịch are now outstanding and unpaid; and,

IT FURTHER APPEARING to the Court that all the territory to be inclided within $s$ aid proposed district is wholly within Sabine County, Pexas:

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas:
1.

That Road Distsict No. 13, of Sabine County, in the State of Texas, be, and the same is hereby eatablished within the following metes and bounds to-wit:

It further appearing that said district does not embrace any part of a political sub division or defined road diatriot that has been heretofore established and has issued bome which are now outstanding and unpaid;

It is therefor e considered and oriered by the Court that on election be held in said Road District No. 13, of Sabine County, Texas, on the 2lst day of webruary, A.D. I925, which is not less than thirty days from the date of this order, to determino whether or not the bonds of said Road District No, l., of Sabine County, rexas, shali be issued in the amount of $\$ 9,000.00$ bearing five and one-half per cent rate of interest and maturing at such times as may fie fixed by the Commissioners Court, serially or otherwise, not to exceed thirty years from the date trerepf; and whether or not a tax ahall be levied upon the property said Road District No. 13, of Sabine County, rexas, subject to taxation, for the purpose' of paying the interest on said bonds and to provide a sinking fund for the redemption thereof at maturity.

The said election shall be held under the provisions of Articles 627, to 64l, inclusite, of Chapter 2," Title 18, Hevided Statutas, 1911, as amended by, Section 1, Chapter 203, Acto of 191?, Kegular Session.

All persons who:are legally qualified voters of this state and of this county, and. who are resident property, tax payers in koad Diatriot No. 13, of Sabine County, Iexas, shall be entitled to vote at said election, and all voters desiring to support the proposition to iṣue the bonds shall have written or printed on their ballots the words:
"For the issuance of. bonds and the levying of the tax in payment thereof."
"And those opposed shll have written or printed on their belanots the words:
"Against the issuance of bonds and the levjing of the tax in payment thereof."
whe polling plases and presiding officerg of said election sheill be respectitely as follaws:

The manner of holding gaid electinneshall be governed by the goneral apari of the stefte of fexas, regulating, general elections, when, not in confliate with the provisions of the Statates hereinabove referred to.
