

The Commissioners Court met in regular meeting on the 9th day of Feb. 1925, with all of the Officers present, to-wit:

The Court allowed the County Officers monthly salary.

A petition signed by W. L. Morris and 25 more citizens asking for the following change in the Hemphill & Hattens Ferry Public Road, to-wit: That when you arrived at the intersection of the old Anthony Ferry Road that you continue the Hemphill & Hattens Ferry road by beginning where the old Anthony Ferry Road leaves Hemphill and Hattens Ferry Road and thence runs Southeast by Franks Smith's place a distance of about Three miles and thence in a Southerly direction from his place and entersection the Hemphill and Hattens Ferry road at the Newton County line.

The change was granted by the Court.

Realizing the impossible position of the Division Engineers the State Highway Department, we the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, are in favor of increasing their salaries to four hundred dollars per month.

On motion by C. W. Fuller, Second by W. J. McDaniel, the Court voted unanimously to sell the remaining \$7500.00 bond in Road District No. 12, Sabine County, Texas, and ordered W. H. Davidson County Judge, to advertise them for sale.

It is ordered by the Commissioners Court of Sabine County, Texas, that 70 acres of the John Horton, League Sabine County, for the year A. D. 1924, be assessed to J. E. Meeks, he being the owner of said 70 acres, and which appears of record on the Unknown Roll, for the year A. D. 1924, and that the same be placed at the sum of \$310.00 dollars, same as said 70 acres was rendered for year A. D. 1923. The tax Assessor of Sabine County, Texas, having taken and accepted said rendition for said year 1924, at said value of \$310.00 and some how or rather same was lost or mislaid and was placed on the unrendered roll for said Year 1924.
