Ordered by the Court to revise the District Clerk's salary from \$780.00 per annum to \$800.00 per annum.

We will pay 3% interest on the net balance of all funds belonging to Sabine County, and agree to carry at par the Road and Bridge Fund, General County Fund Sabine County School Warrants and Jury Fund up to the amount collected in each of the said funds for the year 1924. We are to receive interest at 3% on the warrants we so carry, or be allowed an offset on the amounts so carried against the balances on which we are to pay interest.

This bid is made with the agreement that the Permanent School Fund will be left with the bank for the next two years.
