Ordered by the Court to allow County Officers salaries for February. Ordered by the Court to allow all accounts presented to the Court. Ordered by the Court to cancel warrant #1744 in favor of Enlow Miller, in the sum of \$2.00 out of the R & B Fund issued December 8, 1924, and the Co. Clerk's is ordered to issue another warrant, in favor of Miller for the sum of \$2.00. Ordered by the Court to allow N.W. Ener, \$520.05, for compiling Delinquent Tax Rolls, from 1885 and 1923 inclusive. Ordered by the Court that the County Clerk transilate the old Index to The Deed of Trust Records, in to new Index. Ordered by the Court to declare Road District # 13 carried by 22 votes for Road Bond & 4 votes against. Ordered by the Court to change the Public road leading from Hemphill & San Augustine Public Road, near H.P. Conn's & H. C. Melton place and leading to Bronson so said Road will run on land line between Conn place and Melton place. Ordered by the Court to allow Geo. Oliver \$10.00 and Mrs. Mattie Lakey \$5.00 as County aid. Ordered by the Court that County Treasurer pay J.J. Gamback the amount that was paid as tax for Dr. W.T. Arnold as the amount was collected a second time. Ordered by the Court to divide the P. I Fund as follows:

and the interest collected to be placed in the P. I. County Fund. Ordered by the Court to accept the report of J.J. Gamback Tax Collector. Ordered by the Court to pay Dr. J.D. Cooper \$5.00 for medical services rendered. Ordered by the Court to approve the the First National Bank bond as County Depository. Ordered by the Court to grant the petition presented by J. H. Cooper, A.A. Wilson, and A. J. Howard prey that the hereinafter described territory be added in the Stock Law District known as Milam stock law.

Ordered by the Court to divide the remainder of Funds in Road District # 9 the amount of \$418.00 in Hall Fund and ordered that \$209.00 be placed in Road District # 9 Ragan Fund.
