On this the 13 day of April, 1925 the Hon. Commissioner's Court of Sabine County, Tex. convened in regular session in the court house in Hemphill, with all officers present, to wit:

The Following together with others were had to wit:

A petition presented to the court signed by Eugene McGown and 10 others citizens praying the Court to grant said petition. To change the public road leading from Vance Vickers place to Geneva and Sexton highway at Myrtle Spring Cemetary, change said road to intersect said highway at Eugene Smith place instead of Myrtle Spring Cemetary.

Ordered by the court to grant said petition.

A petition presented to the court signed by L. A. Jordan and 50 other citizens praying the court to build a bridge on Bear Creek about 4 miles west of Pineland, Texas.

Ordered by the court to reject said petition.

A petition presented to the court signed by G. M. Gaskins and 29 others citizens praying the court to grant a public road beginning at the Hemphill and Fairdale road about 1 mile east of T. L. McDaniel place and leading to Sabine River at Lee Travis' place said road to run on the east line of M. F. Carter's land.

Ordered by the court to grant said road.

Ordered by the court allow only \$50.00 expense of opening up said road.

A petition signed by A. E. Brush and 13 other citizens praying the court not to grant said public road as stated above in petition.

Ordered by the court to reject said petition.

Ordered by the court to pay E. D. Britt \$17.50 for skiff to be located at the county Ferry at Pendleton.

Ordered by the court to allow Sylvester Crowell \$10.00 as county aid.

Ordered by the court to accept the resignation of M. F. Jones as constable of Justice Precinct # 8.

Ordered by the court to reject the bill of Minton & Lewis for Transcript of road District # 12.

Ordered by the court to hold up the Bill of F. P. Adams and T. B. Hamilton for Attorneys fee in the case of Knox Lumber Co. Vs. Sabine County.

Ordered by the court to suspend the North road crossing at McElroy Switch on the G. C. & S. F. R. R. Line, so said Company will have only one crossing to keep up, at said Switch.

Ordered by the court to cancel \$5000.00 of insurance on the County Jail wrote by R. H. Minton.

Ordered by the court to take \$5000.00 more Insurance on the Court House.

Ordered by the Court that E. E. Solly is declared elected County School Trustee at large according to returns of School Trustee Election.

ORDER AWARDING BONDS

at which time the following proceedings were had:

Commissioner Ragan presented an order and moved that it be passed, the motion was seconded by Commissioner Ball. The Motion carried with it the passage of the order by the following votes:

AYES: Commissioners Ragan, Ball, Hall and Vickers. The Judge asked to be recorded as voting Aye.

NOES: NONE.

The order is as follows

WHEREAS, immediately prior to April 1st, 1925, the Commissioners' Court had theretofore made diligent effort to sell the bonds of Hemphill County Road District No. 12 in the amount of SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (\$7,500) Dollars (the first \$7,500.00 of the issue having been theretofore sold), bearing five and one-half (5½%) per cent interest dated April 14, 1924, maturing serially from 1940 to 1945, inclusive and considered all offers submitted; and,

WHEREAS, no offer was submitted for the outright purchase of said bonds at a price of as much as par and accrued interest; and,

WHEREAS, the offer of Ben T. Harrison, of Dallas, Texas, was then considered to be in all terms the best, which was to the effect that he would represent the County in finding a purchaser for a price of par and accrued interest, in consideration of the payment to him by said County of the sum of \$1125.00; said amount to be paid to the said Harrison for expenses incurred by him and for services rendered, as and when he should present to the County a customer ready, willing and able to pay and who shall pay the sum of par and accrued interest for said bonds; and,

WHEREAS, said offer of Ben T. Harrison was duly accepted by the Court and became the contract of the county and the District as of April 13, 1925; and,

WHEREAS, Ben T. Harrison, thereafter, has on this date advised the Court that a purchaser of said bonds has been obtained in accordance with its agency contract, at a price of par and accrued interest, which offer and acceptance is as follows, to wit:

"Dallas, Texas, April 8, 1925,

To the Honorable W. H. Davidson, County Judge, and Commissioners' Court, Sabine County,

Hemphill, Texas,

Gentlemen:

For the legally issued Sabine County road District No. 12 bonds of your county in the par value of \$7500.00, delivered to us at Dallas, Texas, dated April 14th, 1924, to mature serially sixteen to thirty years, to be in the denomination of \$500.00, bearing interest from date at the rate of 5½% per annum, payable semi-annually, both principal and interest payable at Hanover Bank, New York City.

WE WILL PAY par and accrued interest to date of delivery. It is expressly understood that

the County will deliver said bonds in strict accordance with its fiscal agency contract with Ben T. Harrison, relieving the purchaser of all liability to said Ben T. Harrison for expenses and for compensation.

This offer is for immediate acceptance, and provided further that prior to the delivery of the above bonds to us and payment made therefor, you are to furnish us with a complete certified copy of the transcript of proceedings to evidence their legality thereof to the satisfaction of our attorney.
