On this the 13th day of July, A.D. 1925, the County Commissioners Court convened in regular session at the regular meeting place thereof in the Courthouse at Hemphill, Texas, all of the members of said Court, to-wit:

W. H. Davidson, County Judge,

C. W. Fuller, Commissioner of Precinct No. 1,

W. J. McDaniel, Commissioner of Precinct No. 2,

J. T. Foely, Commissioners of Precinct No. 3,

R. C. Travis, Commissioner of Precinct No. 4; being present, and passed the following

order:

Whereas, a petition signed by J. H. Travis and twenty-seven other persons on the 21st day of January, A.D. 1925, praying for an election to issue bonds in Road District No. 13, was filed in this Court and whereas, in said petition it was provided that the proceeds of said bonds, if issued, be used and spent upon the following portions of the public roads in said District:

On the road known as the Hemphill and Pineland road beginning at the Southwest boundary line of the town of East Mayfield and continuing in a Southwesterly direction with said road leading from Hemphill to Pineland to the point where said road crosses the East boundary line of Road District No. 10, of Sabine County, Texas, near the present residence of J. H. Travis.

It is ordered by the Court that the proceeds of the sale of said bonds issued by Road District No. 13, when sold, shall only be used upon the following portion of the public roads in said District, to-wit:

On the road known as the Hemphill and Pineland road beginning at the Southwest boundary line of the town of East Mayfield and continuing in a Southwesterly direction with said road leading from Hemphill to Pineland to the point where said road crosses the East boundary line of Road District No. 10, of Sabine County, Texas, near the present residence of J. H. Travis.
